Boundary consolidation by construction of cairns is one of the prime activities of the Forest Department, which is being monitored by Chief Minister’s Project Monitoring Cell, as the Impactful Project of Forest Department. During the year 2019-20, Eastern Circle, Palakkad excelled in boundary consolidation works by constructing 5108 cairns. The target is achieved in full and the number of cairns constructed in the Circle is the highest in the State. The Divisions of Palakkad, Mannarkkad and Nenmara falling under this Circle achieved the targets in full by constructing 1883, 1501 and 1400 cairns respectively. The number of cairns constructed by these Divisions is the highest in the State. The Ranges of Palode, Ottappalam, Alathur, Agali and Mannarkkad also have excelled in achieving the targets by constructing 915, 835, 775,665, 664 cairns respectively, which are the highest numbers in 2019-20 in the State. The above performances is really outstanding considering the liquidity crisis on account of the Treasury restrictions since November, 2019, and the Lockdown declared during the second half of March, 2020 due to the spread of COVID – 19.
