As per Orders read as 1st and 2nd above, 25% of the posts of Senior Superintendents are eligible for ratio promotion as Senior Superintendent (Higher Grade). There are 34 posts of Senior Superintendents in the department. As such eight posts of Senior Superintendents of the department have been upgraded as Senior Superintendent (Higher Grade) and the following eight Senior Superintendents who were eligible, had been sanctioned ratio based higher grade in the post of Senior Superintendent vide the orders read as 3rd above.

As per the Final seniority list of Senior Superintendents as on 01.11.2017, Sri. Santhosh PS (Sl.No.02) is the senior most. But he was superseded in the order referred 4th above, since his Probation in the cadre of Senior Superintendent has not been declared at that time. Vide order referred 5th above Probation of Sri. Santhosh PS has been declared with effect from 05.04.2016 and hence he is eligible to get ratio based Higher Grade in the post of Senior Superintendent with effect from 19.05.2017, i.e. the with effect date in which, ratio based Higher Grade granted to his immediate junior Smt. Sindhu. K, vide order referred 4th above.

In the above circumstances, I, Dr. Amit Mallick. IFS hereby order to sanction ratio based Higher Grade in the post of Senior Superintendent in the scale of pay of Rs. 40,500 – 85,000 to Sri. Santhosh PS, with effect from 19.05.2017.
