#### ORDER NO.D1-22675/2007 DATED: 19.03.2018

The Kerala Public Service Commission selected and advised Smt.Priya.R.Devi for the Forest Rangers Course 2010-11 vide order read 1<sup>st</sup> for filling the vacancies of Range Forest Officers available in the Forest Department earmarked for the Forest Apprentice Category.

The candidate was deputed for 18 months certificate course of Range Forest Officers 2010-11 at the Forest Rangers College, Balaghat, Madhya Pradesh vide order read 2<sup>nd</sup>. She had completed the said course successfully and joined the department on the FN of 05.01.2012.

On completion of Forest Range Officers training, she was deputed for practical training for one year in the department vide order read 3<sup>rd</sup>. But she failed to complete the one year training though five chances had been given to her for the completion of the training. Hence disciplinary action was initiated against her by the Government issuing a Show Cause to her vide order read 4<sup>th</sup> seeking her explanation against the decision of the Government to remove her from service. Meanwhile she approached

the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal at Trivandrum to give her posting as Range Forest Officer. In the interim order of the Hon'ble Tribunal vide order read-5<sup>th</sup> it was ordered to arrange for a practical training to her for the deficient period in the offices wherein she will have to undergo training subjected to final orders. Complying with the order she was deputed for practical training for four weeks vide order read 6<sup>th</sup> in the office of Chief Conservator of Forests (IT) and Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (E &TW).

In the letter read 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>, Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (E &TW) & Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (FMIS) reported that she had successfully completed the practical training. On successful completion of practical training she reported on 29.11.2017. As the final judgment of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal in the above Original Application has not been pronounced, she was not given appointment order and posting order. So she again approached the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal at Trivandrum for getting posting order. The Hon'ble Tribunal vide interim order read 9<sup>th</sup> directed to give appropriate posting order to the applicant subject to the final judgment of the Original Application.

In compliance with the order read 9<sup>th</sup>, Smt.Priya.R.Devi is appointed as Range Forest Officer in the Kerala Forest Department in the scale of pay of Rs.39500-83000 as per rule 9 A of the General Rules in Kerala State Subordinate Service Rule 1958 with effect from 29.11.2017.

The incumbent will be on probation for a period of two years on duty within a continuous service period of three years as per rule 8(i) of the Kerala Forest Service Special Rules 2010. Posting Order will be issued separately subject to the final judgment of the Original Application.
