## **Model Estimate for Forestry Works**

Revised wages for the laboures engaged in forestry operations were decided as per GO (MS) No.7/07/F&WLD, Thiruvananthapuram dated 24/02/2007. The wage rate is applicable as under: -

As per Forest Schedule of Rates in force, number of man mazdoor for each item of work is specified. Depending upon the necessity of work, estimates are passed quoting FSR and applying wage rates.

Since the areas in which operations are done have different physical parameters, it is not possible to have uniform estimates passed for all the places. At the same time, it is observed that in preparing estimates for near similar type of areas, widely varying FSR provisions are used at least in some cases.

Therefore, it was felt that it would be worthwhile to attempt a model estimate for each type of forestry work for discussion and adoption in field to the extent possible. Accordingly the draft is prepared.
