The Kerala Public Service Commission selected and advised the following 15 candidates for the Forest Rangers Course of 2010-2011 vide references **1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>** for filling the vacancies of Range Forest Officers available in the Forest Department under quota earmarked for Direct Recruitment from among candidates who possess a Degree in Science / Engineering

The above mentioned 15 candidates selected and advised by Kerala Public Service Commission were temporarily appointed as Range forest Officers in the Scale of pay of Rs. 20740 36140 vide the order read as 4<sup>th</sup> cited. As per Rule 9 (2) (a) of Kerala Forest Service Special Rules, 2010, the Range Forest Officers appointed by Direct Recruitment under item (i) (a) and (i) (b) and by appointment by transfer under item (iii) (a) and (iii) (b) under category 3 of rule 3 shall undergo 18 months Rangers' training in any of the institutions under the Director of Forestry Education, Government of India. Accordingly they were deputed for 18 months certificate course of Forest Range Officers 2012-14 commenced from 28.08.2012 at the Uttarakhand Forestry Training Institute, Sundarnagar, Himachal Pradesh vide the order read as 4<sup>th</sup> cited.

As per Rule 9 (2)(b) of Kerala Forest Service Special Rules, 2010 Range Forest Officers appointed by Direct Recruitment, on completion of training in the institution shall undergo practical training for one year in the Forest Department. Accordingly on completion of Rangers' training in the institution the 15 candidates were deputed for practical training for one year in the Department on 28.02.2014 as per order read as 5<sup>th</sup> cited. On successful completion of practical training, the above said incumbents reported for posting on the AN of 09.03.2015 and they were transferred and posted as per order read as 6<sup>th</sup> cited.

In order to regularize service, their character and antecedents were got enquired through the Police Department. Concerned Police authorities vide letters mentioned below informed that the above candidates advised by Kerala Public Service Commission are suitable for appointment in regular Government Service. As such the stipulation made in Rule 10 (b) (iii) of KS & SSR is duly satisfied.

In the letter read as 7<sup>th</sup> cited Government clarified that probation in the cadre of Range Forest Officers starts from the date on which the appointee joins duty after successful completion of training (Rangers' Training in the institute) prescribed in clause (a) of sub rule 9 of Kerala Forest Service Special Rules, 2010. Therefore, regularization of appointment can be done from the said date.
