**Order No. D1-27438/2010 Dated 7.10.2013**

Government vide GO read as 1<sup>st</sup> above have granted permission to appoint 21 Deputy Range Forest Officers as Range Forest Officers temporarily under Rule9(a)(i) Part II Kerala State & Subordinate Service Rule. On the basis of the conditions prescribed by Government, Deputy Range Forest Officers up to Sl.No.14 as per the list approved by Government vide G.O read as 1<sup>st</sup> above were promoted to the cadre of Range Forest Officers temporarily as per Rule 9(a) (i) of Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules as per order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> above.

2. Government vide GO read as 3<sup>rd</sup> above has granted permission to include S/Shri M.Padmanabhan, Ramachandran Muttil and C.Shereef Deputy Range Forest Officers as Sl.No 9A,Sl.No11A and Sl.No15A respectively in the approved list of Deputy Range Forest Officers for temporary appointment as Range Forest Officers issued as per G.O read as 1<sup>st</sup> above.

3. Sri.B.Udayakumar, Range Forest Officer has retired from service on 30.09.2013 and Sri,B.Renjith,Range Forest Officer has been deputed for training in Central Detective Agency,Hyderabad. Thus presently there are two vacant post of Range Forest Officers in the Department.

4. Deputy Range Forest Officers S/Sri.M.Padmanabhan,Ramachandran Muttil having seniority No.56 & 59 respectively in the provisional seniority list of Deputy Range Forest Officers as on 01.03.2011 are the next senior most Deputy Range Forest Officers who qualifies the conditions stipulated by Government in the order read as 1<sup>st</sup> above. Their names are also included as Serial No.9A and 11A in the list

approved by Government in the GO read 3<sup>rd</sup> above and as such they are eligible for temporary appointment as Range Forest officer.

5. Under the above circumstances, Deputy Range Forest Officers S/Sri. M. Padmanabhan and Ramachandran Muttill, are appointed temporarily as Range Forest Officer in the scale of pay of Rs. 20,740-36140 as per Rule 9(a) (i) of Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules.

6. The temporary appointment of S/Sri. M. Padmanabhan and Ramachandran Muttill as Range Forest Officer is subject to the following conditions

1. The appointment as Range Forest Officer is over and above the quota fixed for promotion of Deputy Range Forest Officer and therefore this appointment is purely on temporary basis
2. They will be reverted without any notice when eligible hands join duty, if they cannot be accommodated in the respective eligible quota
3. This appointment will be regularized as and when vacancies earmarked for promotion as Range Forest Officer will occur in the respective quota after following the procedures prescribed in the Rules.
