Sub:- Kerala Forest Department – Establishment – Training of Range Forest Officers - Creation of supernumerary posts of Range Forest Officers as training reserve - Interim arrangements – Orders issued.

ORDER NO. D1-24434/14 DATED: 31-03-2015

As per the orders read as 1st above, thirteen Range Forest Officers appointed from among the Deputy Range Officers were deputed for training as stipulated in Rule (9) (h) of the Kerala Forest Service Special Rules, 2010 at Kerala Forest School, Walayar. In order to avoid keeping these ranges vacant as it would adversely affect the smooth functioning of the offices, the temporarily appointed Range Forest Officers in the department were allowed to continue in their respective posts until the training is over. Government were requested to create fifteen supernumerary posts of trainee Range Forest Officers as training reserve for six months for imparting training to all the Range Forest Officers appointed from among the Deputy Range Officers. Orders in this regard are awaited. Presently nine Range Forest Officers are working in the department in excess of the sanctioned post. Since Government orders regarding creation of supernumerary posts as training reserve is awaited drawing of salary by these nine Range Forest Officers without Government sanction would not be proper. Hence salary for the month of March onwards for the following nine junior most temporarily appointed Range Forest Officers may not be drawn and disbursed until further orders.
