Sub:- Leave for study purpose –authority—competent to sanction-Clarification issued—

Ref:- Letter No. E. I. D. 85713/61 DATED 3/6-9-62 from the Chief Engineer (General & Irrigation), Trivandrum.

Rule 91, Part I, Kerala Service Rules provides for the grant of leave for study purposes in the case of temporary or officiating officers. Now a doubt has been raised with regard to the authority competent to sanction leave under the above rule. Government wish to make it clear that leave under Rule 91, Part I, K.S.R. for study purposes can be sanctioned by the authority competent to sanction eligible leave and leave without allowances. Study leave under Rule 99, Part I, K,S.R. on the other hand can be sanctioned only by Government.
