ORDER

The Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (FMIS) vide the letter read as 1st paper above had furnished proposal for the procurement of 40 Nos. of Laser Printers from M/s ACS Technologies Ltd., being the L1 bidder at a total cost of Rs.2,30,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs thirty thousand only) including 3 years warranty.

2. The proposal was discussed in the meeting of the Departmental Purchase Committee held at 3 P.M on 28.01.2014 in which the Chairman opined that not only the basic cost of the equipment but also the recurring cost of consumables like cartridges and yield has to be taken into account. Therefore the Committee suggested the Department to prepare a comparison statement of basic cost, cost of cartridges and yield of cartridges and to propose the lowest bidder.

3. Accordingly the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (FMIS) vide the letter read as 3rd paper above has furnished a Comparative Statement received from 3 firms ie. M/s Ricoh India Pvt. Ltd, M/s CDNS Technologies India (Pvt) Ltd and M/s ACS Technologies, recommending the proposal from M/s ACS Technologies considering the fact that price of the machine is lowest.
