NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendments to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

AMENDMENT

C.S.No.8/62 dated 29-3-1962.

In part I of the said Rules, in rule 92-(i) in clause (ii) for the words “twelve complete months”, the words “ten complete months” shall be substituted, and (2) for the note, the following exception and note shall be substituted, namely”-

“Exception-An Officer who proceeds on earned leave from a post the maximum pay of which does not exceed Rs.100 per mensem is entitled to leave salary equal to the pay drawn immediately before proceeding on leave”; and

“Note”- The words “the ten complete months proceeding the month in which the leave commences” occurring in the above rule should be interpreted literally, Thus, if an officer, who was on leave from 23rd August, 1959 to 26th October,1959, both days inclusive, is granted leave from 3rd March 1960, his average pay should be calculated on the pay earned for the periods from 1st may, 1959 to 22ndAugust 1959 and 27th October 1959 to 29th February 1960. If, however, an officer happens to have been on leave for more than 10 months immediately preceding the month in which the leave is taken, then

the average should be taken of the monthly pay earned during the 10 complete months immediately preceding the month in which the previous leave commenced.

Any period of joining time taken under rule 125(b) during the preceding 10 months should be ignored in calculating average pay as no pay is drawn in respect of such joining time.

Example—A Gazetted Officer, who was on leave from 14th April 1960 to 5th May 1960 both days inclusive, is granted leave from 12th August 1960. In order to arrive at his average pay the total pay earned for the periods of duty, viz., from 1st October, 1959 to 13th April 1960, and from 7th May, 1960 to 31st July, 1960 should be divided by 6 plus $\frac{13}{30}$ plus $\frac{25}{11}$ plus 2 = $\frac{8593}{930}$ months, the fractions $\frac{13}{30}$ and $\frac{25}{31}$ presenting period of duty in terms of months in April and May 1960 respectively. Where x is the total pay earned by duty from 1st October 1959 to 13th April 1960 and from 7th May 1960 to 31st July 1960, the average pay is equal to $\frac{930}{x} \times 8593$.
