**ORDER**

In U.O.No 435-Code 1/27-74 dated 5-7-1974 the Controller and Auditor General of India had suggested a revision of the procedure for the recovery of pension and leave salary contribution from the foreign employer's. The intention of the proposed revision is that the recovery of Foreign Service contribution is to be made only once in a year and at the end of the financial year or at the end of the term of Foreign Service if the term of deputation terminates during the course of a financial year. This procedure reduces the frequency of recovery during a financial year, the Accountant General; Kerala in his letter first cited suggested that a similar procedure may be adopted in this state. Government, after careful examination of the proposal, are pleased to make suitable provision in the service Rules. Accordingly the following notification is issued.

**NOTIFICATION**

**S.R.O.No. 437/76**-In exercise of the power conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala public Service Act,1958 (19 of 1968) read with Section 3 thereof of the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to Kerala Service Rules; namely:-

AMENDMENT  
C.S.No.288/76

In part I of the said, for rule 150, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

“150. If a contribution for leave salary or pension, due in respect of an officer on Foreign Service, is not paid within fifteen days from the end of financial year or at the end of Foreign Service. is not paid within fifteen days from the end of financial year or at the end of foreign service. if the deputation on for service comes to an end before the end of a financial year interest may be paid to government on the unpaid contribution ,unless it is specifically remitted by government , at the rate of two paise per day per Rs.100

from the date of expiry of the period of fifteen days up to the date on which contribution is finally paid.

The interest shall be paid by the officer or the foreign employer according as the contribution is paid by the former or the latter.
