O R D E R

Under Rule 150 Part I Kerala Service Rules post can be created for the sole purpose or lending the services of the officers concerned to autonomous/ private institutions on condition that the cost of the post are wholly or partly met by the beneficiaries for whose services such posts are created . It has come to the notice of Government that the posts thus created are reckoned for fixation of order strength and rule promotion in certain department but in certain other Departments, it is not being reckoned for these purpose.

2. Rule 12 (4) of Kerala services Rules part I defines ‘order’ as the strength of a services or part of a service sanctioned as a separate unit. Temporary posts created under Rule 156 part I Kerala service Rules cannot be reckoned as part of the parent cadre, as such posts will have to be abolished as soon as the purpose for which the posts are created cadre ceases to exist . Government are therefore pleased to clarify that posts created under rules 156 part I K. S. R.S. The cost of which are re-imbursed by the beneficiary agencies, will not be reckoned for fixation of cadre strength and ratio promotion.
