ORDER

It is observed that in practice the Accountant General is not sanctioning Anticipatory pension under rule 146 Part 111 K.S.Rs in a number of cases where there is like hood of liabilities , without a positive recommendation from the departmental Officers . Generally the latter take a long time to asses even the approximate liabilities with the result that the pensioner has to go without any pensioner benefits till the liabilities are assessed and settled , resulting in extreme hardship . But in the case of officers against whom Departmental / judicial proceedings have been instituted rule 3 A ibid envisages the payment of a provisional pension not exceeding the maximum pension admissible . Such being the case it would be unfair if some anticipatory pension at least is not sanctioned in cases where liabilities are only suspected or proved but not assessed . Having considered the question in all aspects Government are pleased to order that in cases where any liability is suspected or proved against an Officer and the money value thereof is not assessed , anticipatory pension not exceeding 2/3 ds of the pension admissible , be paid to him without any anticipatory death cum - Retirement Gratuity . This will not cover cases to be dealt with under the provision of rule 3

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India , the Governor of Kerala l hereby makes the following amendments to K. S.Rs namely

C.S NO 61/65 / Fin Dated, Trivandrum 9 Th April 1965

In part 111 of the said rules:-

In rule 146, the following note shall be inserted namely:-

“Note: - When any liability is suspected or proved against an Officer and the money value thereof is not assessed , the quantum of pension to be disbursed under sub rule (a) shall not exceed 2/3 rds of the admissible amount and no Death – Cum - Retirement Gratuity shall be payable under sub rule (b) . This does not cover cases to be dealt with under the provisions of rule 3 A supra”.
