ORDERS

As per the G.O.read above, part time contingent employees will be granted earned leave for their service from 1-7-88 at the rate of 1/22 of the period spent on duty subject to a maximum of 15 days in a year and they will be permitted to surrender ended leave as in the case of regular employees. Certain Heads of Departments raised a doubt as to wither the number of days of Earned leave that can be surrendered by a part time, Contingent employee in a year is limited to 15 and whether there is any limit for the accumulation of Earned leave at credit. Government is pleased to order as follows.

Part time contingent employees are permitted to surrender entered leave on two occasions subject to a maximum of 20 days in a year. The maximum earned leave that cans accommodated in the case of part time contingent employees will be 120 days. The will also be permitted to surrendered the whole balance of earned leave at credit at the time of termination of service
