O R D E R

According to the explanation below rule 75, Part I, Kerala Service Rule an officer will be deemed to have been denied leave preparatory to retirement if he has ascertained in writing that leave if applied for would not be granted in the exigencies of public service. Government decidedthe officer should specifically apply for leave preparatory to retirementis in need of it and that its denial or grant should be entirely at the discretion of the sanctioning authority with due regard to the exigencies of public service. With a view to implementing this decision Government are released to issue the following notification.

NOTIFICATION

S.R.O.No. 378/72,- In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968) read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

C.S.No. 241/72.

In rule 75 in the said Rules, in Part I the existing Explanation shall be substituted by the following.

“For the purpose of this rule an officer will be deemed to have been denied leave only if within sufficient time before the date on which he must compulsorily retire of the

date on which his duties finally cease he has formally applied for the leave has been refused in writing by Government in the exigencies of Public Service.
