**ORDER**

R le 14 (1) (C) (ii) of the General Provident Fund (Madras) Rules provides for the grant to a subscriber to the fund of a fresh temporary advance when an earlier temporary advance is outstanding against him. There is a similar provision under the General Provident Fund (Central Services) Rules also. But according to the State Provident Fund (Travancore) and General Provident Fund (Cochin) Rules, a second temporary advance is not allowed until after the complete repayment of the previous advance with interest and not until after 12 months have elapsed thereafter.

2 Government feel that the liberal provisions governing the grant of temporary advance to the subscribers obtaining under the General Provident Fund (Madras) Rules should in fairness and equity be extended to the subscribers governed by S.L F (Travancore) and G.P F. (Cochin) Rules also.

3. Accordingly Government are pleased to order that Rule 11 of the S P F (Travancore) and Rule 12 (i) of the G.P.F (Cochin) Rules will be amended on the lines of Rule 14 (1) © of the G 1521.

4. These orders will come in to effect immediately. Formal amendments to the S.P.F (Cochin) and S P F (Travancore) Rules will Issued in due course as ordered above.
