ORDER

In the G.Os read as 1st and 2nd papers, the benefit of minimum pension of Rs.45 with effect from 1-3-1972 respectively sanctioned to state pensioners and the temporary increase in pension with effect from 1-7-1974 sanctioned in the G.O.3rd cited to all service pensioners who retired prior to 1-7-1973 and whose basic pension not exceed Rs.100 P.M. was extended to palace pensioners (Nithiachilavu pensioners). In the G.O.5th cited sanction was accorded to allow some increase to the low paid pensioners. Shri .S.Rama Iyer in his representation 6th cited has requested on behalf of the Nithiachilavu pensioners of the state to extend the benefit contemplated in the G.O.5th cited to the Palace pensioners (Nithiachilavu Pensioners) also.

2. Government have considered the question in detail and are pleased to order that the benefit of increase in pension ordered in the G.O.5th cited will be extended to the palace pensioners (Nithiachilavu pensioners)also.

3. These orders take effect from April 1.1976, i.e.pension for April due for payment in May, 1976.
