As Per rule 48,Part I, Kerala Service Rules, one-third of any non-Recurring fee exceeding Rs. 400 or one-third of any recurring fee exceeding Rs.250 a year paid to an officer shall be credited to the General Revenues. These monetary limits were fixed way back in 1965.Government have reviewed the matter and have decided to enhance the limits.

2. Accordingly, the limits of Rs.400 and Rs.250 a year shall be revised as Rs. 2000 and Rs. 1250 a year.

3. Formal amendment to the Kerala Service Rules will follow.
