Public Service-Filing up of the vacancies through Public Service Commission-Directions to the Head of department/Appointing Authorities-orders issued.

ORDER

In the G.O. read above orders were issued that all vacancies which are likely to continue beyond three months should be reported to the Public Service Commission for advising candidates for regular appointment. Government have issued from time to time instructions to the Heads of Departments and appointing authorities that vacancies which are to be filled up by the PSC hands should be reported to the Commission forth with so that the commission can advise candidates from the ranked lists. In spite of these instructions, Government are receiving complaints that certain Heads of Departments and appointing authorities are not reporting vacancies in various posts particularly posts of L. D. Clerk and Last Grade Servants to Public Service Commission promptly.

2. Government, therefore, order that all the Heads of department and appointing authorities should report the vacancies particularly of L.D. Clerks and Last Grade Service which are to be filled up through Public Service Commission, to the Public Service Commission forthwith so that the commission can advise candidates from the ranked lists. The Heads of Departments/appointing authorities should also ensure that such vacancies when arise are reported to the Public Service Commission promptly.

3. The Director of Public Relations will give wide publicity to the above instruction through media.
