O R D E R

In the G.O. read first paper above, the monetary limit in the exception below rule 93, Part I, Kerala Service Rules has been enhanced from Rs.605 to Rs.1,015. It has come to the notice of Government that there is difficulty in calculating leave salary for Half Pay Leave as the existing minimum pay is Rs.550. Government have examined the question in detail and are pleased to order that the monetary limit of Rs.1,015 in the exception below Rule 93 Part I, Kerala Service Rules ordered in the G.O., read as first paper above is enhanced to rs.1,100.

2. The above orders will take effect from 1.4.1985. In respect of officers who select to remain in the pre-revision scales of pay beyond 1-4-1985. The monetary limit in exception below Rule 93, Part I, Kerala Service Rules would continue to be Rs.605.
