ORDER

A monthly conveyance Allowance has been sanctioned to certain categories of physically Handicapped employees. The benefit was extended to physically Handicapped part-time Contingent Employees at a reduced rate of Rs. 25 p.m.

2. Government are now pleased to sanction a conveyance allowance of Rs. 25 (Rupees twenty five only per mensem to physically Handicapped permanent labourers on time scale and casual labourers on rolls on daily wages, subject to the conditions laid down in the G. Os. Read as first and second paper above.

3. In the case of casual labourers on rolls the above allowance will be paid taking into account the number of days they have worked, the full-month rate being Rs. 25 (Twenty five).

4. These orders will take effect from the date of this G. O viz. 28-11-1984
