As per the existing rules, commuted leave shall be granted to an officer in permanent employ, subject to the conditions, specified in Rule 84 Part I, Kerala Service Rules on the basis of medical certificate only. For some time past, Government have been considering the question of dispensing with the system of insisting medical certificate for sanctioning commuted leave.

Government are, now, pleased to order that the system of requiring medical certificate for commutation of half pay leave will be dispensed with, hereafter.

Necessary amendment to the Kerala Service Rules will be issued separately.
