ORDER

Government have examined the question whether in order that an officer may become eligible for surrender of Earned Leave and the leave salary and allowances therefore he should have prospective service to cover he entire period of the leave surrendered and the leave taken for the purpose of surrender. They are please to clarify as follows:-

- (i) In order that an officer may become eligible for surrender of a maximum of 30 days' Earned Leave in terms of Para 3 (a) of G.O. (P) 605 70/Fin. Dated 26-8-1970 or the orders issued earlier, the officer should have prospective service only to cover the Earned Leave taken for the purpose of surrender.
  - (ii) In order that an officer may become eligible for surrender of a maximum period of 15 days' Earned Leave in terms of Para 3(b) of G.O. (P)605/70 Fin. Dated 26-8-1970 he need not have prospective service to cover the period of the leave surrendered.
  - (iii) As the benefit of surrender of Earned Leave will not be allowed in cases of leave preparatory to retirement, the officer should be on duty at least for one day just before the date of his retirement.
2. These orders will apply to all past cases also.
