ORDER

In the Government Order read as second paper above, orders have been issued allowing the benefit of higher grade to all the Non-Gazetted Officers who remain in the entry grade without a promotion in the normal course, on completion of 13 years of service in the entry grade. Detailed instructions regarding the implementation of the orders contained in the said Government Order have been issued in the Government Order third cited.

- 2. Certain Heads of Departments have sought clarification whether employees who were transferred from Madras and Mysore States on mutual transfer basis as per Government Order first cited, are eligible for higher grade, reckoning their past services in other States.
- 3. Government have examined the case in detail. According to para 2 (ii) of the Government Order third cited, all periods counting for increments in the entry grade/post shall be treated as qualifying service for the purpose of computing 13 years' period for granting the higher grade. In the Government Order first cited, the conditions for the transfer of officers from Madras/Mysore states on a mutual basis have been laid down. As per condition No.1 of the said Government order, the persons transferred will be allowed to count their previous service i.e. service under the Government of Madras/Mysore as the case may be, towards increment, pension, gratuity, etc. In the circumstances, Government are pleased to order that the previous service of the employees who got mutual transfer to this State as per Government Order first cited, will be reckoned for the grant of higher grade ordered in the Government Order third cited, subject to the other conditions prescribed therein.
