NOTIFICATION

S.R.O.NO.1204/80.----In exercise of the powers conferred by section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Rules further to amend the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

Rules

C.S.No. 382/80

1. (i) These rules may be called the Kerala Service (Amendment) Rules, 1980.
(ii) They shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from the 1st day of July, 1975.
2. In part I of the Kerala Service Rules, in rule 31, after Note 6, the following Note shall be added, namely:-

“Note 7:- In the case of an officer of non-vacation department sent on deputation for training to an institution having regular vacation his eligibility for earned leave shall be decided as follows:-

- (1) if the officer is not permitted to enjoy the vacation and is retained by the institution for duty, and if the head of the institution so certifies the officer shall be considered as on duty during that period and earned leave

for that period shall be admissible to him in accordance with the provisions of rules 78 and 79.

- (2) If the officer enjoys only part of the vacation, deduction of earned leave will be in such proportion of 30 days as the number of days of vacation enjoyed bears to the full vacation.”

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification but is intended to indicate its general purport).

There is no provision in Kerala Service Rules for calculating earned leave in the case of officers or non-vacation departments sent on deputation for training to institutions having regular vacation. This notification is intended to lay down rules for determining eligibility of earned leave of such officers.
