Sub: - Pension Claims - Liability fixed against
Retired officers – clarified orders –
Ref: - GO (P) 274/86/Fin DT 31-8-86

As per Rule 3 Note 2 in Part 111 F.S.R Liabilities fixed against an employee can be recovered from D.C.R.G payable to him without the departmental / judicial proceedings but after giving the employee concerned a reasonable opportunity to explain . Further Government in the G.O under reference have issued amendment to the above rule stating that the liabilities of an employee should be quantified and intimated to him before retirement or after retirement within a period of 3 years on becoming pensioner . Thus liabilities of a pensioner should be quantified and intimated to him . Recently in another case Government have also directed the liabilities fixed against a pensioner after 3 years of his retirement should not be recovered from his D.C. R.C . In the above circumstances , all officer are requested to see that the liability against the retired personnel should be settled within three years from the date of retirement .
