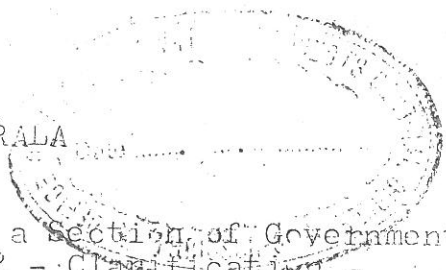

Public Service - Indefinite strike by a Section of Government Employees and Teachers from 6.2.2002 - Classification - Orders Issued

ORDER

In the context of the strike by a Section of Government Employees and Teachers from 6.2.2002 to 8.3.2002, certain employees arrested under the provisions of Kerala Essential Service Maintenance Act, 1994 and charged criminal cases were later remanded to custody in Jails. Certain service organisations have requested Government to treat the period between the date of Withdrawal of strike and release from jails as duty. The Government have examined the matter and are pleased to order that the period between the date of withdrawal of strike and release from jails will be treated as duty provided no disciplinary action is pending and no cases are pending against them involving violence including destruction of Public Property and bodily harm.
