Sri.Jabir P., Managing Partner, M/s Wayanad Timbers, Karani P.O., Meenangadi, Wayanad, has submitted an application for the renewal of the property mark registration of the firm "M/s Wayanad Timbers," bearing the property mark "W.T.," as per first reference cited above. The firm's depot is located on an extent of land measuring 0.4310 hectares in Resurvey Block No. 144, Re-survey No. 23 (old Survey No.317/12, 317/13 of Varambetta Village, Vythiri Taluk. The said land is under the possession and enjoyment of the applicant Sri Jabir P., and the other partners of the firm, namely Sri Nihad A.M. and Sri Shahul Hameed.

The office of the aforementioned firm is functioning in a building bearing Door No. 527/9 of Kaniyambetta Grama Panchayat, which is also jointly owned by the applicant Sri Jabir P, and the other partners of the firm, namely Sri Nihad A.M. and Sri Shahul Hameed. The Deed of

Partnership has been duly executed between the Managing Partner and the other partners of the firm.

The applicant has produced Possession certificate, Building Certificate, Land tax receipt, Building tax certificate, Location sketch and a copy of the partnership deed.

The Range Forest Officer, Kalpetta, has conducted a site inspection 18.04.2026 and submitted a report as per the 2nd reference cited. As per the inspection report, the land utilized for the depot does not fall under the categories of Vested Forests, Ecologically Fragile Land (EFL), WCS land, Tribal Land, Section 5 Notified Land, or Revenue Land. It is further clarified that the said land is not proposed to be vested as Left-out Vested Forest or Ecologically Fragile Land (EFL). The existing depot site is situated at an approximate distance of 5 km from the nearest forest land.

The Range Forest Officer has also reported that no forest offence cases have been registered against the applicant till date. Considering the aforementioned facts, the Range Forest Officer, Kalpetta, has recommended the renewal of the property mark registration of the firm, as requested by Sri.Jabir.P, Managing Partner, M/s Wayanad Timbers, Karani P.O., Meenangadi, Wayanad.

In view of the aforementioned facts, the Range Forest Officer, Kalpetta, has recommended the renewal of the property mark registration of the firm, as requested by Sri Jabir P., Managing Partner, M/s Wayanad Timbers, Karani P.O., Meenangadi, Wayanad.

Pursuant to the 3rd and 4th references cited above, the fee for property mark registration for a period of five years has been revised to ₹10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with effect from 27.08.2024. In compliance with this revision, the applicant has remitted the registration fee of ₹10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) through e-Treasury, vide e-Challan No. GRN: KL002777126202627E dated 20.04.2026, along with the applicable GST.

In view of the foregoing facts and circumstances and based on the recommendation of the Range Forest Officer, Kalpetta, **I, Ashique Ali U**, Divisional Forest Officer, South Wayanad Division, Kalpetta, do hereby order that the property mark registration "**W.T.**" is renewed in favour of Sri. Jabir.P, Managing Partner, M/s Wayanad Timbers, Karani P.O, Meenangadi, Wayanad, for a period of five years, from 2026-27 to 2030-31, expiring on 31.03.2031.

The applicant is hereby permitted to handle approximately 8000 m³ of round logs, 3000 m³ of sawn timber, and 5000 MT of billets/cut ends of various species, including Rosewood, Teakwood, and other specified timber species, from the depot to various destinations and vice versa, in strict compliance with the Kerala Forest Produce Transit Rules, 1975. This permission is granted under **Property Mark Certificate No. 01/2026-27 to 2030-2031 dated 20.04.2025**, issued from this office, with a validity period up to 31.03.2031, and is subject to the following conditions:

- 1) The trading of timber shall be carried out in accordance with the Kerala Forest Produce Transit Rules, 1975.
- 2) Transport of timber from and to the depot should be in accordance with the judgments dated 09.01.2001, 22.11.2001 etc. in O.P.No.30589/2001 of the Hon'ble High Court and related CMPs in the O.P and subsequent orders in the above O.P and CMPs.
- 3) The passes issued under the property mark registration shall not be misused under any circumstances.
- 4) Necessary Form IV white permits shall be obtained from the Divisional Forest Officer, South Wayanad Division, Kalpetta. The dates of receipt and issue of Form IV permits shall be entered in a separate register.
- 5) All columns and particulars in each Form IV white permit shall be duly and properly filled in. The number of logs, quantity, species name, cubic contents, destination, route, time allowed for removal, etc., shall invariably be recorded. A separate register shall be maintained showing

the daily receipt, disposal, and closing balance of timber on each day. The stock register of timber and permits shall be properly maintained and shall be produced for inspection as and when required.

- 6) The monthly returns pertaining to the receipt and disposal of timber, together with duplicates of Form IV white permits, shall be submitted to the Divisional Forest Officer, South Wayanad Division, Kalpetta, on or before the 10th day of every succeeding month. The property mark holder shall also furnish the details of receipt and disposal of timber to the Range Forest Officer, Kalpetta, within 24 hours. Upon receipt of such intimation, the Range Forest Officer, Kalpetta, shall conduct an inspection of the depot at the earliest opportunity, verify the relevant records and materials, and ensure that the timber so collected is genuine and that the conditions stipulated in the orders of the Hon'ble High Court are duly complied with.
- 7) The Proprietor of the firm, his assignee, his legal heirs, his men, or agents or workers engaged by him should not commit any offence or violate any provisions of the Kerala Forest Act 1961, the Kerala Forest Produce Transit Rules 1975, the Kerala Preservation of Trees Act 1986, the Kerala Promotion of Tree Growth in non Forest Areas Act 2005 and other acts and rules related to Forest and Wildlife.
- 8) The property mark holder shall be held responsible for any violation of the provisions of the said Act and Rules by any of the persons mentioned above.
- 9) Violation of any of the above conditions shall entail cancellation of the property mark registration, in addition to initiating legal action against the firm and its partners under the relevant provisions of the Act and Rules.

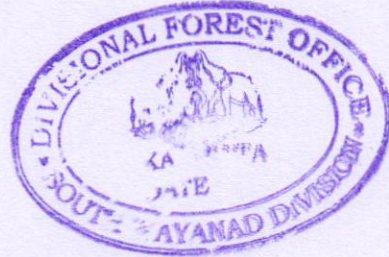
