N.Hamza, Proprietor, M/s Malabar Timber, Choondal, Thrissur has requested to renew the PMR of the Firm 'M/s Malabar Timber, Choondal', functioning in re-Survey No.385/2 Choondal Village, Kunnankulam, Thaluk as per reference 1st cited. Consequent to the expiry of the registration granted to the firm from this office vide order 2nd read above. The Range Forest Officer, Wadakkanchery has conducted enquiry on the application submitted report with recommendation to renew the PMR as per reference 4th cited. As per the Govt. order cited in the 5th reference the fee for the renewal of PMR for 5 years is Rs.10000/- . The applicant has remitted Rs. 10000/- (Ten thousand only) to worth the renewal fee for registration of PMR vide e-Chalan GRN.No.KL014864439202627 E dated 23.06.2026 and produced the same in this office

In the above circumstances, I, K.J.MARTIN LOWEL IFS , Divisional Forest Officer, Thrissur Division, do hereby order to renew the PMR in respect of M/S Malabar Timber, Choondal, for a further period of 5 years from 2026-27 to 2030-31. With an anticipating turn over of miscellaneous wood logs 2,000 cum, miscellaneous wood sizes 2000 cum, teak wood logs 2000 cum, teak wood size 2000 cum, teak poles 1000 numbers. From the Depot at re-survey no. 385/2 of Choondal Village, Kunnankulam, Thaluk in accordance with Kerala Forest Produce Transits Rules 1975 and as per certificate no.4/2026 -2031 issued from this office with validity up to 31.03.2031 and subject to the following conditions.

- 1) The property mark is valid only for dealing the registered quantity of timber for the period up to 31.03.2031.
- 2) Dealing of the timber shall be as per the norms in Kerala Forest Produce Transit Rules 1975.
- 3) Transport of timber from and to the depot should be in accordance with the judgements dated 09.01.2001, 22.11.2001 etc. in O.P.No.30589/2001 of the Hon'ble High Court and related CMPs in the O.P and subsequent orders in the above O.P and CMPs.
- 4) The passes issued under the property mark registration should not be misused under any circumstances.
- 5) Necessary Form IV White Permit should be obtained from Divisional Forest Officer, Thrissur. Date of receipt and issue of Form IV permits should be entered in separate Register. Date of issue of each Form IV permits should be invariably recorded in words also.

- 6) All the columns / details of each Form IV permit should be properly filled up. The number of logs, quantity with name of species cubical contents etc, destination, route, time allowed for removal etc. should be invariably entered. Daily receipt and disposal of timber and balance stock on every day should be maintained in separate register. Stock Register of timber and permits should be properly maintained and to be produced for inspection as and when required.
- 7) *The Monthly returns of receipt and disposal of timber and duplicates of Form IV white permits should be submitted to Divisional Forest Officer, Thrissur before 10th of every succeeding month.* The property mark holder should inform the Range Forest Officer, Wadakkanchery the details of receipt and disposal of timber with in 24 hours. Range Forest Officer, Wadakkanchery shall inspect the Depot and verify the records and materials soon on getting information about the genuineness of the timber collected, and correctness of the dealing, and satisfy himself that the conditions of Hon'ble High Court orders have not been violated.
- 8) The Proprietor of the firm, his assignee, his legal heirs, his men, or agents or workers engaged by him should not commit any offence or violate any provisions of the Kerala Forest Act 1961, the Kerala Forest Produce Transit Rules 1975, the Kerala Preservation of Trees Act 1986 and other acts and rules related to Forest and Wildlife.
- 9) The property mark holder will be held responsible for violation of any of the provisions of the above said acts and rules by any of the persons mentioned above.
- 10) Violation of any of the above conditions will entail cancellation of the property mark besides legal action against the firm and the partner under the relevant provisions of the act and rules.
