In connection with Bharana Bhasha Malayalam Celebrations for the year 2019, it has been decided to conduct competitions for Malayalam Language Skills for IFS Officers from outside Kerala working in Kerala Cadre of Forest Department. The following guidelines are issued.

- 1) Two venue centers have been proposed for entire state of Kerala.
  - a. Eastern Circle Office, Palakkad for officers from Thrissur Districts and other Northern Districts.
  - b. Forest headquarters, Vazhuthacaud, Thiruvananthapuram for the officers from other districts.
- 2) All participants in the competitions shall be Kerala Cadre IFS Officers from outside Kerala.
- 3) The competition shall be conducted from 2.00 PM to 3.30 PM and the time schedule is as follows:
  - a. 2.00 PM Registration
  - b. 2.30 PM to 3.30 PM Competition period comprises of questions on finding mistakes in Malayalam sentences, translation of sentences from English to Malayalam and translation of Malayalam words to English.
    - (The questions shall be emailed to the personal email ID of Conservator of Forests (Eastern Circle), Palakkad by 1.00 PM so that sufficient copies can be printed and distributed to the participants by 2.30 PM. In the answer sheets only Registration numbers shall be entered.
- 4) The answer sheets shall be mailed to the official email ID of the Conservator of Forests (SA), Forest Headquarters, Vazhuthacaud, Thiruvananthapuram. (ca-sano.for@kerala.gov.in)
- 5) Expenditure in connection with stationeries, light refreshments will be met from this office for which a duly certified bill mentioning the details of bank account of beneficiaries may be produced.
- 6) Answer sheets shall be verified by the judges comprising of three experts from Malayalam language.
- 7) 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners shall be awarded with memento and proper certificates at a function to be held in Forest Headquarters on a date to be informed later..
