Sub: Motor Vehicles – Exhibition of name boards in motor vehicles owned

by Government Departments/Public Undertakings/Corporation etc...

Government have issued orders as per G O first cited to exhibit the name of the Government Departments/Corporations/Boards on the body of the vehicles so as to indentify the vehicles easily and also to check to some extent the misuse of the vehicles. As per the Circular dated 07-09-1982 referred to above, it was also directed that the name of Department/Corporation/Boards etc.., may be written in the front and back i.e., just above the grill in front and to the left portion of the dicky in the rear as per the specifications mentioned therein. It has now come to the notice of Government that vehicles belonging to the Public Sector Units and Government Departments are not clearly displaying, the identity of the Company/Board/Departments which own them. In the circumstance, the following further instructions are issued for immediate compliance.

- 1 : The Government departmental vehicles will exhibit a board each in front and rear, indicating the department to which they belong. The background of the board will be red and the letters will be in white.
- 2 : The vehicles allotted to the Ministers and those similarly assigned will bear the board, Kerala State and a number. The background of the board will be red and the letters will be in white.
- 3 : The Public Sector Units' vehicles will not display 'Kerala State' board.
- 4 : The vehicles owned by Public Sector Units/Boards will display a rectangular board in front indicating the name of Public Sector Unit/Board

on top and the letters "A State Government Undertaking" below the name of the Undertaking and a circular board, in rear, indicating the name of Company either in full or in appropriate abbreviated forms. The background of both the boards will be light blue and the letters in black.

5: The size of the letters in all cases shall be that of the Registration letters and numbers prescribed in Rule 50 of Central Motor Vehicles Rule-89. The name shall be written in English in self-illuminating paints.
