I am directed to refer to DoPT's letters dated 27.05.2024, 28.06.2024 and 31.07.2024 regarding extension of timelines for recording of PARs for the year 2023-24. In this regard, it has come to notice that still some reporting officers have not recorded their remarks in PARs.

2. Accordingly, the matter has been duly considered in this Department and it has been decided to further extend the timelines of PAR in case of Reporting Authority only, as indicated below:

- 4. Notwithstanding anything contained herein, no remarks may be recorded after 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2024 in the PAR of AIS officers for the PAR year 2023-24, in accordance with the 2<sup>nd</sup> proviso of the AIS (PAR) Rules, 2007, as amended.
