I am directed to invite your attention on the above mentioned subject and to say that the attention of the Ministry has been drawn by several user agencies as well as Federation of Indian Mining Industries that as per Para 4.7 of Guideline issued under Forest Conservation Act 1980 inter-alia provides that 7.5 Meters strip all along the outer boundary of the mining lease area shall be maintained as safety zone area, and the clarification issued vide this Ministry's letter No. 11-125/2015-FC, dated 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2015 that the safety zone would be kept within the mining lease boundary. Area of safety zone of mining shall be a part of the total area of the mining lease.

2. It has been seen that guidelines requiring shifting of safety zone inside the mining lease is not feasible for those mining plan which has been approved by the IBM in which safety zone is outside the mining lease area and mining is continuing as per the approved mining plan. Such Mining leases for specified area were executed by the State Government when safety zone was not the part of the mining lease i.e. prior to 27<sup>th</sup> May 2015 and the forest clearances were granted for mining lease area plus the safety zone area prior to 27<sup>th</sup> May 2015.
