**Order No.A4-1664/2019 dated 07.12.2019**

The rates of rent for Inspection Bungalows, Dormitories, Community Halls, Watch Towers etc under the control of the Kerala Forest Department has been enhanced vide Government Order read 2<sup>nd</sup> above. Accordingly a Proceedings order read 3<sup>rd</sup> above has been issue showing the new rates and further as per order read 4<sup>th</sup> above, clarifications regarding the rent collection has also been issued.

In the above two Proceedings orders, certain instructions regarding the reservation of rooms specified in the government order read 1<sup>st</sup> above were not included.

Therefore, the following guidelines regarding the reservation of rooms are hereby issued in continuation to the Proceedings order read 4<sup>th</sup> above.

1. Officers who are posted on transfer to a district shall be given accommodation on official rates in the Guest House situated in the district concerned for a maximum period of 5 days starting from initial posting to that office.
2. No Government officers of either State or All India Service shall be allowed to stay in the Guest House for more than 10 days at a time. If any officer is permitted to stay in Government Guest House on official visit for more than 10 days as a special case, he will be

charged half the normal rates for the next 10 days and on full rent for the remaining days. This shall be applicable to the All India Service officers who are joining duty after deputation/transfer also.

3. Probationers of All India Services shall be provided with accommodation for the entire period of training on official rates provided no quarters are available in that district for them.
