Vide reference cited 1st above, Administrative sanction was accorded to Forest Department for implementation of the project under Rebuild Kerala Development Programme (RKDP) for a total amount of Rs 800.00 crores. A three tier committee was constituted vide reference 2nd above for the implementation and monitoring of the project which are as follows:-

1. State Level Empowered Committee (SLEC)
2. Project Management Unit (PMU) at Forest Headquarters
3. Regional Committees (RC) at Circle Level

As per the approved DPR of RKDP, and vide G.O(Rt)No.225/2020/F&WLD dated 30-09-2020, a Project Manager is to be hired as part of the PMU on contract basis for the effective coordination of project activities. The third SLEC meeting held on 26-03-2021 had approved an amount of Rs.45000/- per month as cost of remuneration for engaging a Project Manager. As per the minutes of the fifth SLEC

vide reference 3rd cited, Special Officer RKDP was authorized to proceed with the selection process for hiring a new Project Manager on contract. Further, a selection panel for hiring a Project Manager for PMU was constituted vide reference 4th cited.

As per the reference 5th cited, the notification to the post of Project Manager was appended to the Director I & PR Department for publication in the dailies in Kerala. The last date for submission of application as per the notification was on 27-06-2022. Accordingly, 28 applications were received. As per reference 6th cited, this office had scrutinized and accepted 27 applications and intimated the applicants to attend the written test and interview on 20th July 2022 at Forest Headquarters, Thiruvananthapuram with all relevant documents. Out of the 27 applicants, 15 applicants attended the written test and interview. The selection panel was under the chairmanship of PCCF (P&D) and the members of the panel were Special Officer, RKDP, Member Secretary, Kerala State Biodiversity Board and Deputy Conservator of Forest, RKDP. Based on the combined highest score secured in the written test and interview, the select list of the applicants is prepared as below:
