**ORDER NO.D1-27438/2010 DATED 16.08.2014**

As per the order read as 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> above, 25 Range Forest Officers advised by the Kerala Public Service Commission were deputed for 18 months Range Forest Officers course at the Andhra Pradesh Forest Academy, Dulappally, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh. Of this, Sri.K.Srinivasan was relieved from the course as he got appointment as Assistant Professor in the College of Forestry, Kerala Agricultural University. The remaining 24 candidates had successfully completed the course and were deputed for one year practical training in the department.


As per the order read as 4<sup>th</sup> above, Government accorded sanction for the creation of supernumerary posts of Trainee Range Forest Officers for the period till the training of the Trainee Range Forest Officers ends. Such posts will be coterminous with the training and will not be perpetuated further. The vacancies arising in the post earmarked for Public Service Commission recruits will be filled up by appointment from among the Department Officers (Deputy Range Forest Officers) on provisional basis. It was specifically ordered that the appointees will be reverted back to the regular posts when Public Service Commission recruits join duty on completion of training.

Of the 24 candidates deputed for field training, Sri.David Camus.D, Range Forest Officer (trainee) got appointment as Scientist in the Agricultural Research Service in the Indian Council for Agricultural Research and was relieved from the training. Smt.K.Neethu,

Range Forest Officer (trainee) had entered into maternity leave from 18.06.2014 to 14.12.2014 and Smt.Sreedevi Madhusudhanan Range Forest Officer (trainee) has not completed the practical training. The remaining 21 Range Forest Officers (trainees) have reported for posting on the AN of 16.08.2014.

In the above circumstances, as ordered in the Government order read as 4<sup>th</sup> above the following temporarily appointed Range Forest Officers are reverted to the post of Deputy Range Forest Officers with effect from the AN of 16.08.2014. Necessary posting orders will be issued separately.
