Sub: Kerala Forest Department – Establishment - Temporary appointment of Deputy Range Officers to the cadre of Range Forest Officers - orders issued.

As per the Government order read as 2nd above, five Range Forest Officers were promoted as Assistant Conservator of Forests and posting orders were also issued. Sri.Stephen Stanley.D, Range Forest Officer, Charpa Range and Sri.Sasi.V, Range Forest Officer, Ayyapancovil Range have retired from service on the AN of 31.10.2014. Sri.Manoj.A.P., Range Forest Officer, Social Forestry Range, Kannur has expired on 18.10.2014. Thus presently there are eight vacancies of Range Forest Officer in the department.

As per the order read as 1st above, temporarily appointed 9 Range Forest Officers were reverted to the post of Deputy Range Forest Officer. Of the reverted 9 Range Forest Officers, Sri.P.Vinu was temporarily promoted as Range Forest Officer as per the order read as 4th above. Moreover, as per the order read as 3rd above, Government have accorded permission to appoint Deputy Range Officer Sri.Priyadarsan.P, Deputy Range Forest Officer temporarily as Range Forest Officer. One post of Range Forest Officer is kept aside for giving posting order to the Range Forest Officer trainee who has reported for posting orders after completion of departmental training.

Under the above circumstances, the following seven Deputy Range Forest Officers are appointed temporarily as Range Forest Officer in the scale of pay of Rs. 20,740-36140 as per Rule 9(a) (i) of Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules.

The temporary appointment of the above said Deputy Range Forest Officers as Range Forest Officers is subject to the following conditions.

1. The appointment as Range Forest Officer is over and above the quota fixed for promotion of Deputy Range Forest Officer and therefore this appointment is purely on temporary basis
 2. He will be reverted without any notice when eligible hands join duty, if they cannot be accommodated in the respective eligible quota
 3. This appointment will be regularized as and when vacancies earmarked for promotion as Range Forest Officer will occur in the respective quota after following the procedures prescribed in the Rules.
