Areas to cease to be reserved forests.

Under the provisions of section 24 of the Madras Forest Act, 1882 (Madras Act V of 1882), His Excellency the Governor of Madras is hereby pleased to notify that the area specified in the schedule below which forms part of the Kalakad forest declared to be reserved forest under section 25 of the said Act in Notification No. 11, dated the 20th December 1883, published at page 38 of Part I of the *Fort St. George Gazette*, dated the 22nd June 1884, shall cease to be reserved forest with effect from the date of publication of this notification:—

SCHEDULE.

Tinnevely district, Nanguneri taluk, Malayadiputhur village.

[Portion of the Thirukurungudy-Kalakad Reserved Forest I. Comprising 0.86 acre of land.]

DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARIES.

North.—Starting from a point which is 375 links in distance with a bearing of 157° from the south-eastern corner of S.F. No. 498, the line runs east for a distance of 270 links with bearing 104° .

East.—Thence the line runs in a southerly direction with the following bearings and distances:—

Brief description.—The area specified above forms an isolated block lying to the south-east of S. No. 498.

Growth on this area is of the usual semi-shola type and contains no exploitable trees.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Madras Forest Act, 1882 (Madras Act V of 1882), His Excellency the Governor of Madras is hereby pleased to notify that the area specified in the schedule below, which was declared to be a reserved forest under section 16 of the said Act in Revenue Department Notification No. 37, dated the 10th December 1913, published on pages 106 to 114 of Part I of the *Fort St. George Gazette*, dated the 27th July 1914, shall, with effect on and from the 1st January 1941 cease to be reserved forest:—

SCHEDULE.

Coimbatore district, Kollegal taluk.

[Name of the forest disreserved—Madeswaranmalai reserved forest (part). Area—4.48 acres.]

BOUNDARIES.

North.—Starting from a point 383 links east, south-east of the fourth boundary stone (counting from the south-west corner) on the southern boundary of Survey Field No. 47 of Gopinatham, hamlet of Ponnachi village, a straight line along the said boundary of S.F. No. 47 for a distance of 1,166 links to the fifth boundary stone.

East.—Thence a straight line with a bearing of 192° for a distance of 400 links.

South.—Thence a straight line with a bearing of 291° for a distance of 1,170 links.

West.—Thence a straight line with a bearing of 6° for a distance of 370 links to the starting point.

Limits of the Nulpoya reserved forest redefined.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 17-A of the Madras Forest Act, 1882 (Madras Act V of 1882), His Excellency the Governor of Madras is hereby pleased to redefine the limits of Nulpoya reserved forest, Wynaad taluk, Malabar district, so as to remove the defects in the description of the limits of the said forest in Revenue Department Notification No. 160, dated the 8th June 1885, published at page 422 of Part I of the *Fort St. George Gazette*, dated the 23rd June 1885, by making the following correction to the limits of the said forest:—

CORRECTION.

For the existing schedule, substitute the following schedule, namely:—

SCHEDULE.

Malabar district, Wynaad taluk, Nulpula amsam and desam.

[Name of forest—Nulpoya reserved forest. Area—3,892.46 acres.]

BOUNDARIES.

North.—Starting from the south-west corner of S. No. 567 of Nulpula desam (on the eastern side of subdivision No. 719 of the Sultan's Battery-Nellakotta road), the south sides of S. Nos. 567, 582, 567 again, 599, 613, 617, 618, 619 and 641 to the westernmost corner of S. No. 645; thence the west sides of S. Nos. 645 and 657, north side of S. No. 662, east, north and west sides of S. No. 663, north side of S. No. 662 again, the east, north and west sides of S. No. 664, north and west sides of S. Nos. 665 and 666, south side of S. No. 667, the west side of S. No. 668, the north-west and south sides of S. No. 669, west and south sides of S. No. 672, west sides of S. Nos. 674 and 673, the south sides of S. Nos. 675 and 676; the south, east and north sides of S. No. 675 again, the east sides of S. Nos. 674, 672 and 670, the south, east and north sides of S. No. 671, the east sides of S. Nos. 670 and 662, the south side of S. No. 705-5, the south and the east sides of S. No. 660, the south sides of S. Nos. 658 and 705-4, the south side of S. No. 656, the south and east sides of S. Nos. 655, 654 and 653, the west, south and east sides of S. No. 652, the east side of S. No. 656 again, the south side of S. No. 649, west and south sides of S. No. 651, the south sides of S. Nos. 649 again; the south sides of S. Nos. 648 and 647 to the south-east corner of the latter on the east margin of the Naikatti-Mudumalai road.

East.—Thence the east margin of the said road to the northernmost corner of S. No. 347, thence its north and east sides to its southernmost corner on the Naikatti-Mudumalai road; thence the east margin of the said road to the north-west corner of S. No. 685; thence the west sides of S. Nos. 685, 704, 702, 701, 700, 705-2, 694, 692, 693 and 691-1 B, the north, west and south sides of S. No. 691-2 A, the west sides of S. Nos. 691-1 C, 689, 691-1 D, 705-3, 687 and 684 to the Nilgiri district boundary (Gudalur taluk).

South.—Thence the said district boundary to the east margin of Sultan's Battery-Nellakotta road (subdivision No. 746).

West.—Thence the said margin of the said road (S. Nos. 745, 744 and 743 part of Nulpula desam) to the south-west corner of S. No. 681; thence the south sides of S. No. 681, the east sides of S. No. 679, the east, north and west sides of S. No. 677, and the north sides of S. No. 679, to the east margin of the Sultan's Battery-Nellakotta road (S. No. 739). Thence the east margin of the said road (S. Nos. 739 part to 719) to the starting point.

NOTE.—The reserve comprises the whole of S. Nos. 705-1, 347, 348, 691-1 A, 706, 682, 683 and 707 of Nulpula desam.

REMARKS.

A. The following rights of way are admitted within the reserve:—

(1) Road from Naikatti to Mudumalai passing through this reserve along the eastern boundary, is open to people, cattle and carts. It is 10 yards wide and 1 mile 5 furlongs and 4 chains in length. It enters the reserve at the south-east corner of S. No. 647 of Nulpula desam, runs generally in a south-easterly direction and leaves the reserve at the north-west corner of S. No. 685 of Nulpula desam.

(2) Sultan's Battery-Nellakotta Deviation road, passing through this reserve is open to people, cattle and carts. It is 10 yards wide and 3 furlongs and 9 chains in length. It enters the reserve, 4 chains north from the westernmost corner of S. No. 706 of Nulpula desam, runs generally northwards for 1 furlong and 1 chain and thence generally southwards for 2 furlongs and 8 chains and leaves the reserve at the north-west corner of S. No. 744 of Nulpula desam.

B. The Jain and Bet Kurumbars residing in this reserve are permitted to continue therein and enjoy their present privileges until they have been provided for elsewhere. In the meantime, they will be tenants-at-will of the Forest Department.
