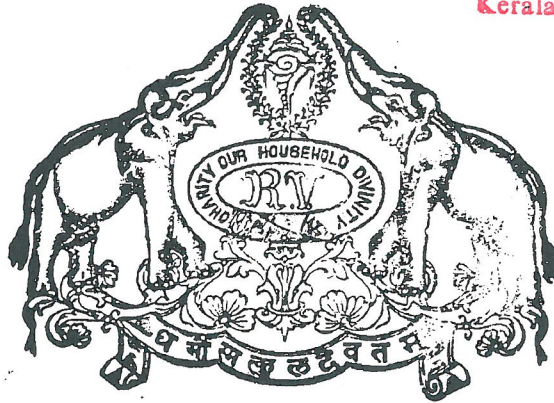

With the sanction of His Highness the Maha Raja, it is hereby notified under Section 18 of the Travancore Forest Regulation II of 1068 as amended by Regulations IV of 1071, IX of 1085, IV of 1089 and VIII of 1079, that from and after the date of publication of this notification in the Gazette, the tract specified in the subjoin schedule shall be deemed to be a Reserved Forest.

Cairns have been erected along the boundaries of the reserve and a correct description of the boundaries with reference to the cairns is hereto appended for the information of the public.

Name of Reserve:	Arudai Fuel Reserve.
Revenue Division:	Devicolum
Taluk:	Peermade
Village:	Peermade
Extent:	94.49 acres

Situation:— This reserve is situated to the east of the Peermade Grazing Block and on both sides of the portion of the Valanjankanam road near the Arudai village and comprises S. Nos. 176/237 and 176/242 of the Peermade Pakuthi.

Boundaries.

North:— Starting from cairn No. 1 at the north western corner of the reserve from a point on the eastern boundary of the Peermade grazing block about 1 1/2 chains south-east of cairn No. 3 of that block the line runs nearly east along the southern boundary of S. No. 176/236 of Peermade Pakuthi for about 5 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 2 to cairn No. 3, thence nearly south-east along the said boundary for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 4 at the theodolite station on the south east corner of S. No. 176/236; thence in the same direction but more to the south for about 5 1/4 chains along the eastern boundary of S. No. 176/237 to cairn No. 5; thence nearly south along the said boundary for about 5 1/2 chains passing cairn No. 6 to cairn No. 7 at a theodolite station; thence nearly east along the said boundary for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 8 at a theodolite station; thence nearly east south-east crossing a stream for about 4 1/2 chains along the said boundary to cairn No. 9 at a theodolite station; thence nearly south-east along the said boundary for about 7 chains crossing a stream and passing cairn Nos. 10 and 11 to cairn No. 12 at a theodolite station on the south-west corner of S. No. 176/1 N; thence nearly south along the said boundary for about 4 1/2 chains passing cairn No. 13 and crossing a stream to cairn No. 14 at a theodolite station; thence nearly south-east along the said boundary for about 5 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 15 to cairn No. 16 at a theodolite station; thence nearly north along the said boundary for about 2 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 17 to cairn No. 18; thence nearly east south-east along the said boundary for about 1 1/4 chains to cairn No. 19 at a theodolite station on the western side of the road from Valanjankanam to Kottayam Kumili road; thence nearly south along the said boundary for about 9 1/2 chains along the western side of the above said road passing cairn Nos. 20 to 22 to cairn No. 23 at a theodolite station where S. Nos. 176/1, 441 and 176/237 meet; thence the line goes nearly west along the said boundary for about 1 1/4 chains to cairn No. 24 at a theodolite station; thence nearly south-east along the said boundary for about 3 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 25 to cairn No. 26 at a theodolite station; thence nearly south along the said boundary for about 3 chains crossing a stream to cairn No. 27 at a theodolite station; thence nearly east along the said boundary for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 28 at a theodolite station; thence more or less south south-east along the said boundary for about 9 3/4 chains crossing a stream between cairn Nos. 31 and 32 passing cairn Nos. 29 to 31 to cairn No. 32 at a theodolite station; thence nearly north east for about 7 1/2 chains passing cairn Nos. 33 to 35 to cairn No. 36 at a theodolite station on the north west corner of S. No. 176/239 on the western side of the road from Valanjankanam Kottayam Kumili road; thence nearly east north east for about 1 1/2 chains crossing the above road to cairn No. 37 at a theodolite station on the eastern side of the above road; thence nearly south east for about 1/2 a chain along the western boundary of S. No. 176/1 J to cairn No. 38 at a theodolite station; thence nearly south along the said boundary for about 1 chain to cairn No. 39 at a theodolite station on the south west corner of S. No. 176/1 J; thence nearly south east along the southern western boundary of S. No. 176/241 for about 5 1/4 chains to cairn No. 40 at a theodolite station at its southern most corner; thence nearly north east along the eastern boundary of S. No. 176/241 for about 3 1/2 chains to cairn No. 41 at a theodolite station; thence nearly north along the northern boundary of S. No. 176/242 for about 3 3/4 chains to cairn No. 42 at a theodolite station; thence nearly north east along the said boundary for about 1 1/4 chains to cairn No. 43 at a theodolite station on the southern bank of the Arudai river; thence along the said boundary the line follows the course of the Arudai river along its south bank eastward for about 40 3/4 chains where another stream which forms the southern boundary of the fuel reserve joins it.

East and South: From there the boundary goes nearly west south west along the southern boundary of S. No. 176/242 for about 45 3/4 chains along the northern bank of the stream to cairn No. 44 on the north east corner of S. No. 176/1 F; thence west north west along
