

5. EDATHORAI RESERVED FOREST

NOTIFICATION

Fort St.George, September 24, 1938.

No.782. – In exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (4) of section 17-A, of the Madras Forest Act, 1882 (Madras Act V of 1882) the Government of Madras are hereby pleased to redefine the limits of Edathorai Reserved Forest, Wynad Taluk, Malbar District, so as to remove the defects in the description of the limits of the said Forest in Revenue Department Notification No.634, dated the 2nd December 1895, published at page 1425 of Part I of the Fort St.George Gazette, dated the 11th December 1895, by making the following correction to the limits of the said forest.

Correction

For the Schedule to the said notification, the following schedule shall be substituted; namely:

Schedule

Malabar District, Wynaad Taluk, Nulpuzha Amsom, Nulpuzha Desom

(Name of Forest: Edathorai – Area in acres 587.98)

Boundaries

North: Starting from the north-east corner of survey No.319, the boundary line runs along the southern margin of Sultans Battery Gundelpet road until it meets the Mavinhalla Reserved Forest boundary (survey No.287/1).

East: Thence southwards along the Mavinhalla Reserved Forest boundary until it meets the eastern boundary of survey No.295.

South: Thence the line runs along the northern half of the eastern boundary of survey No.295, east sides of No.294, east and north sides of No.289, north and west sides of No.290, west sides of survey Nos.291, 292 and 293 to the trijunction of survey Nos.293, 297 and 296, thence the north and west sides of survey No.297 until it meets the southernmost corner of the last mentioned Sy.No. Thence along the west sides of Survey Nos.296,298 and 299 to the south-west corner of the last mentioned field (trijunction of survey Nos.299, 300 and 302) thence along the north sides of survey Nos.302 and 303 to the north-west corner of survey no.303 where the line meets Mavinhalla Reserved Forest Boundary.

West: Thence northwards along the said Reserved Forest boundary till it meets the south-east corner of survey No.306, thence along its south and west sides to its north-west corner thence along the south side of survey No.287/1 (part) till it meets the eastern most corner of survey No.307, thence it east south and west sides, west sides of No.287/1 (part) till it meets the south-east corner of Survey No. 309; thence along the east sides of survey Nos.309 and 310, south and east sides of Survey

No.317, south, east and north sides of No.318, east sides of No.317, again and No.319 to the starting point of the northern boundary.

The reserve comprises survey Nos.283, 288, 287/1 (part) 306 and 307 of Nulpuzha desom.

Remarks: (a) The following rights of way are allowed –

(i) Right of way for men and cattle 4 feet wide and 25 chains long leading from the south-west corner of survey No.285 to the northernmost corner of survey No.290.

(ii) Right of way for men and cattle 4 feet wide and 10 chains in length leading from the northernmost corner of survey No.284 and running northwards to the Sultans Battery Gundelpet road (survey No.250).

(b). The following survey numbers are admitted as an enclosure:

No.284- 15.95 acres – No.285- 0.97 acres – No.286 – 8.51 acres.
