| Kalanjoor Teak Plantation Reserve | Enadimangalam and Pathanapuram Pakuthies | Kunnathoor and Pathanapuram Taluks | Quilon | <p>Situation: The Block lies about a mile east of Kalanjoor village site, west of Vazhappara stream and comprises portions of survey Nos. 884/1 and 906 of Enadimangalam Pakuthy, Kunnathoor Taluk and portions of survey Nos. 376/1 and 382/6 of Pathanapuram Pakuthy, Pathanapuram Taluk.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Boundary Description</i></p> <p>North:- Starting from cairn No. 1 situated about 5 ½ chains east of the Taluk boundary stone on the south-east corner of S. No. 883/4 of Enadimangalam Pakuthy, Kunnathoor Taluk, the line runs east south-east for about 5 chains to cairn No.2 thence, south-east for about 5 chains to cairn No. 3, thence east north-east for about 10 ¼ chains passing cairn No.4 to cairn No.5, thence north by slightly west for about 6 ¼ chains to cairn No. 6, thence north north-west for about 4 chains to cairn No.7, thence more or less north-east for about 1 ½ chains passing cairn Nos. 8 to10, to cairn No.11 thence, more or less north for about 28 ¼ chains passing cairn No.12 to16 to cairn No.17, thence south-east for about 17 chains passing cairn No. 18 to C. No. 19.</p> | 127.4 Acres |

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| | | | <p>East:- Thence south south-east for about 6 ½ chains passing cairn No. 20 to cairn No.21 situated on the right bank of Vazhappara stream, thence the line runs southward along the same bank of the above stream to cairn No. 22, situated on the same bank of the stream where the Taluk boundary between Kunnathoor and Pathanapuram Taluks crosses the stream, thence south for about a chain along the above Taluk boundary stone at the junction of survey Nos. 884/1 and 906 of Enadimangalam Pakuthy. Thence southward along the same Taluk boundary forming the western boundary of the Chethelvetty Reserve passing cairn Nos. 24 to 27 to cairn No. 28 at a Taluk boundary stone on the north-east corner of survey No. 376/1 of Pathanapuram Pakuthy, thence south, south-west for about 3 ½ chains crossing the Vazhappara stream to cairn No. 29, situated on the southern bank of the field channel, thence south south-east for about one chain to cairn No. 30 situated about ¼ of a chain, south-west of the south-west corner of survey No. 381/1 of Pathanapuram Pakuthy.</p> <p>South:- Thence south-west for about 2 ¾ chains to cairn No. 31 on the north side of survey No. 382/3, thence west for about 3 chains along the north side of the above survey No. to cairn No. 32 on the north-west corner of the above survey number, thence south south-west for about 4 ¾ chains to cairn No.33 about ½ of a chain north-west of the western most corner of survey No. 382/3, thence west north-west for about 7 ¼ chains passing cairn No. 34 to cairn No.35 about ¼ of a chain south-east of the south-east corner of the survey No. 383/8, thence north by slightly east for about 5 chains passing cairn No. 36, to cairn No. 37, on the north-east corner of survey No.383/8, thence west north-west for about 4 chains along the north side of the above said survey No., to cairn No.38 at its north-west corner thence north north-east for about 3 ½ chains along the east side of survey No. 383/7 to cairn No. 37, thence north-west for about 1 ½ chains to cairn No. 40, thence north-east for about 5 chains to cairn No.41 about a chain north-east of the north-east corner of survey No.383/7 thence west north-west for about a chain, to cairn No.42 about ¾ of a chain north-east of the north-west corner of the above said survey No. thence west south-west for about 5 ½ chains to cairn No.43 situated on the left bank of Vazhappara stream.</p> | |
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| | | | <p>West:- Thence north along the same bank of the same stream, to cairn No.44 situated about 4 chains south south-east of the south-east corner of survey No. 883/4 of Enadimangalam Pakuthy, thence north-east for about 5 chains crossing the stream and the Taluk boundaries to meet the cairn No.1 at the starting point on the north boundary.</p> <p>I. <i>Private Rights:</i> As the claim for a portion of survey No. 377/7 admitted by the Forest Settlement Officer has now been excluded from the Reserve by alteration of the boundary , there are no private rights within the Reserve.</p> <p>II. PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY AND C, ADMITTED</p> <p>(1) <i>Vazhappara Stream:</i> Length within the reserve is about 44 chains and average breadth about 65 links. This stream enters the Reserve between cairn Nos. 28 and 29, its right bank being 12 links south of cairn No.28 and runs west north-west for about 9 ½ chains thence taking a sharp course goes south-west for about 17 chains. It exits the Reserve between cairn Nos. 44 and 1, its left bank being about 90 links north-east of cairn No.44.</p> <p>(2) <i>Food path from the 2nd mile of Pathanapuram-Konni road to Padom:-</i> Length of the path within the Reserve is about 45 ½ chains and its breadth 15 links. It enters the reserve between cairn Nos. 44 and 1 about 1 ½ chains south of the later cairn and goes almost in a southeasterly direction for about 34 chains then in a northerly direction for about 11 ½ chains till it meets the cairn no. 24 where it leaves the Reserve.</p> <p><i>Another Foot Path:-</i> About 20 chains long within the Reserve and 15 links broad. This foot path starts from the above foot path from the place where it runs from the north. It goes in a south south-westerly direction for about 7 ½ chains, then it leaves the Reserve between cairn Nos. 28 and 29 at about 2 ½ chains east from the former cairn. Again it enters the Reserve just north of cairn No.29 and goes in a south westerly direction for about 12 ½ chains to cairn No. 35, where it exits the reserve.</p> | |
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N.B:- The right of way to the Public and cattle at all times through the above foot paths and stream is granted.
