The draft notification under section 16 of the Forest Act for the Kanakamajalu block in the Kasaragod taluk of the south Canara district will be submitted to Government for approval and publication in the Fort St. George Gazette.

**NOTIFICATION**

His Excellency the Governor in Council is pleased to declare, under the provisions of section 16 of the Madras Forest Act (V of 1882), that, from the 1st May 1901, the area, the boundaries of which are set forth in the schedule appended to this notification shall be constituted a ‘Reserved forest’.

One hundred and thirty yards south of the south-western corner of Nujibaily cultivation (muli warg No.32 of Mudnur village), the reserve boundary runs east three hundred and fifty yards to cairn No. 2 thence south two hundred and twenty yards to cairns no.3 overlooking Nadubail cultivation (Muli warg No.26 of Mudnur village) from the west; thence passing along the west side of that cultivation and the south side of Pernaje (muli warg No.37 of the same village) and Yerahalabail (geni warg No.1) south-south-east two hundred and eighty yards and one hundred and forty yards to cairn Nos.4 and 5, east-north-east One hundred and seventy yards to cairn No.6 and nearly in the same direction one hundred and thirty yards and one hundred and fifty yards to cairns Nos. 7 and 8, north-east one hundred and fifteen yards to cairn No.9, east slightly north one hundred and ninety five yards to cairn No.10 north east one hundred and fifteen yards to cairn No.9, east slightly north one hundred and ninety five yards to cairn No.10 north east one hundred and eighty yards to cairn No.11 east two hundred and forty-five yards to cairn No.12 east slightly south three hundred and ten yards to cairn No.13 east slightly north one hundred and eighty yards to cairn No.14 and north-east one hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.15 overlooking Kallucharpe darkhast (Hosagame warg No.58 of Mudnur village) thence passing along the south of that cultivation and excluding an strip of and of geni warg No.1 of Mundnur village from the reserve east slightly south one hundred and thirty five yards to cairn No.16 east -north -east one hundred and seventy yards to cairn No.17 and north-north-west the same distance to cairn No.18 on the south side of the Local Fund road from Puttur to Mercara opposite the forty-third mile, sixth furlong thereon; thence that side of the road eastward for about one and three-fourths of a furlong to cairn No.19 opposite the forty-fourth mile stone and overlooking Guddadka cultivation (muli warg No.1 of Kanakamajalu village from the north-west; thence excluding that cultivation from the reserve, south slightly west one hundred and sixty five yards to cairn No.20, south-south-west one hundred and eighty yards and two hundred yards to cairns Nos. 21 and 22, south-east three hundred and thirty yards to cairn No.23, north-east two hundred and five yards to cairn No.24, north-north-west one hundred and eighty yards to cairn No.25 and north-east two hundred yards and the hundred and fifty yards to cairn Nos.26 and 27, the last-mentioned cairn being again on the south side of the Local Fund road above

mentioned; then again that side of the road east-south eastward for about six furlongs to cairn No.28 opposite the forty-fifth mile stone thereon and overlooking Panjigundi cultivation (muli wargs Nos.31, 15 and 2 of Kanakamajalu village) from the west.

**East :** Thence south one hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.29, south slightly west one hundred and ten yards to cairn No.30 and south-south-west two hundred yards to cairn No.31 overlooking Mulimajal cultivation (muli warg No.15 of Kanakamajalu village); thence skirting that cultivation on the west, south three hundred and the ten yards to cairn No.32, south-west two hundred yards to cairn No.33 and west-south west the same distance to cairn No.34 overlooking Nidil cultivation (geni warg No.2 of Kanakamajalu village); thence passing along the northern and western sides of that cultivation and the western, southern and eastern sides of Bollukall cultivation (muli warg No.28 of the same village) west, slightly north, three hundred and thirty yards to cairn No.35, south slightly west two hundred and five yards to cairn No.36m south south-east two hundred and eighty yards to cairn No.37, east one hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.38 and north slightly east one hundred and eighty yards to cairn No.39 thence passing along the south of geni warg No.1 and muli warg Nos. 12 and 13 of Kanakamajalu village, east slightly south hundred and fifty yards, south-south-west to hundred and sixty-five yards to cairn No.43 overlooking Uggamule cultivation (muli warg No.19 of Kanakamajalu village) then passing along the south side of that cultivation and he west and south sides of Badimule (muli wargs Nos. 24 and 26 of the same village), east-south-east two hundred and forty-five yards and two hundred and twenty yards to cairn Nos. 44 and 45, south slightly east two hundred and ninety-five yards to cairn No.46 east two hundred and ninety-five yards to cairn No.46 south slightly west one hundred and fifty yards to cairn No.47 and east two hundred and sixty yards to cairn No.48; thence passing along the northern, western and southern sides of Kudukoly cultivation (muli warg No.6 of Kanakamajalu village) south two hundred yards to cairn No.49 west slightly south one hundred and ninety yards to cairn No.50, west one hundred and thirty-five yards to cairn No.51 south two hundred yards to cairn No.52, south east three hundred and ten yards to cairn No.53 east one hundred and sixty yards to cairn No.54, east-north-east two hundred yards and two hundred and sixty yards to cairn Nos. 55 and 56; thence north-east one hundred and ninety yards to cairn No.57 and north-east two hundred yards to cairn No.58 overlooking Kabbinahitlumule cultivation (muli wargs Nos.11 and 16 of Kanakamajaly villages); thence north slightly east two hundred and twenty five yards to cairn No.59, east slightly north two hundred and sixty-five yards to cairn No.60, south-south-west one hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.61, south slightly east two hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.62, east one hundred and five yards to cairn No.63, north slightly west one hundred and

sixty yards to cairn No.64, east north-east one hundred and ten yards to cairn No.65, south-east one hundred and seventy-five yards to cairn No.66, south-south-east the same distance to cairn No.67, east slightly south one hundred and seventy yards and one hundred and seventy yards to cairn Nos. 68 and 69 the last mentioned cairn overlooking Kadikadka cultivation (geni warg No.1 of Jalsur village); thence south-south-east three hundred and thirty yards to cairn No.70 overlooking darkhast muli Nos.7 and 32 of Jalsur village; thence east-south-east eighty yards to cairn No.71 on the west side of the Local Fund road from Kasaragod to Jalsur; thence that side of the road southward for about four furlongs to cairn No.72 opposite the thirtieth mile stone thereon and overlooking Mapladka cultivation (muli warg No.25 of Jalsur); thence across the road south forty-four yards to cairn No.73 on the south side of the road; then passing along the southern and western sides of Mapladka cultivation, east-south-east ninety yards to cairn No.74, east slightly north one hundred and eighty yards and one hundred and thirty-five yards to cairn Nos.75 and 76 and south three hundred and thirty yards to cairn No.77 on the north bank of the Paishvani river.

**South:** Thence that bank of the river westward for about six and one-fourth furlongs to cairn No.78 on the same bank; thence north-west sixty yards to cairn No.79 on the north side of the Kasaragod Jalsur Local fund road and overlooking Panjikallu cultivation (muli warg No.3 of Bellipad village); then passing along the western and northern sides of that cultivation, north-north-west one hundred and ten yards to cairn No.80, north-west two hundred yards to cairn No.81 north-north-west one hundred and thirty yards to cairn No.82 and west slightly north the same distance to cairn No.96 of the Parappa reserved forest; thence the boundary of that reserve to cairn No.95 thereof; thence north-north-east one hundred and thirty-five yards to cairn No.83 overlooking Markanji cultivation (muli wargs No.5, 11 and 12 of Bellipady village) from the south; then passing long the south side of that cultivation and round Amaykadu (muli warg No.13 of the same village), east two hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.84, south-south-east one hundred and sixty –five yards to cairn No.85, south-east two hundred and eighty-five yards to No.86, and east-south-east two hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.87 on the east side of the Kasaragod – Jalsur Local fund road; thence that side of the road north-east ward for about a furlong to cairn No.88 on the same side thereof; then passing along the north side of Amaykadu cultivation above mentioned, north-west one hundred and sixty five yards to cairn No.89 and west-north –west two hundred yards to cairn No.90; thence north-east one hundred and thirty-five yards to cairn No.91; east one hundred and thirty yards one hundred and 60 yards and one hundred and 15 yards to cairn Nos.92,93 and 94 the last mentioned cairn being to the west side of a bend on the Kasaragod-Jalsur Local Fund road; then that side of the road north-east ward for

about half-a-furlong to cairn No.95 on the same side thereof; thence north-north-east one hundred yards to cairn No.96 and north-west ninety yards to cairn No.97 overlooking Permbar cultivation (muli warg No.10 of Bellipadi village); then passing round the eastern, northern and western sides of that cultivation north-north-east two hundred and sixty yards to claim No.98, west slightly north two hundred and forty yards to cairn No.99, south-west two hundred yards to cairn No.100 and south-south-west one hundred and fifty five yards to carn no. 101, then pasing along the north side of Markanji cultivation (mulli warges Nos.8, 11 & 12 of Bellipady village); west-north-west two hundred and twenty five yards to cairn No No.102, north west one hundred and thirty yards to cairn No.103, west one hundred and seventy five yards to cairn No .104, south-south-west one hundred and thirty yards to cairn No.105 west slightly north two hundred and forty yards and three hundred yards to cairn Nos.106 and 107. The last mentioned cairn overlooking Madiala Parppa cultivation (muli warg No.11 of Bellipady village); then passing along the eastern northern and western sides of that cultivation and Chamber darkhast (geni wag No.13 of Bellipady village), north-north-west two hundred yards, two hundred and seventy yards and two hundred and thirty yards to cairns Nos.108, 109 and 110, north-west one hundred and seventy yards, one hundred and sixty-five yards and one hundred and ten yards to cairns Nos.111, 112 and 113, west slightly north two hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.114, south slightly east ninety yards to cairn No.115 east slightly south one hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.116, south one hundred yards to cairn No.117, south-south-west one hundred and thirty five yards to cairn No.118, south-south-east two hundred and forty yards to cairn No.119, and south two hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.120; thence west slightly south one hundred and ninety yards to cairn No.121 overlooking the cultivation of muli wargs Nos.4 and 5 of Bellipady village; then passing along the east side of that cultivation and the eastern, northern and western sides of Mulemajal, Madagada mule and Balekody cultivations of muli warg No.3 of the same village, north-west two hundred and sixty yards to cairn No.122, north two hundred and forty yards to cairn No.123, north-north-west one hundred and seventy yards to cairn No.124, west two hundred and sixty yards and one hundred and fifty yards to cairns Nos.125 and 126, north-north-west one hundred and ten yards to cairn No.127, west slightly south one hundred and thirty yards to cairn No.128, south one hundred and thirty-five yards to cairn No.129, south-south-west two hundred and twenty yards and two hundred and thirty-five yards to cairns Nos.130 and 131 and south slightly east one hundred and forty yards to cairn No.132 overlooking the cultivations of muli wargs Nos.4 and 5 of Bellipady village; thence west slightly north two hundred and fifty yards and two hundred and forty yards to cairns Nos. 133 and 134.

**West :** Thence north-north-west two hundred yards to cairn No.135, north two hundred and sixty yards to cairn No.136 and north-north-east one hundred fifty-five yards to cairn No.137 overlooking Maratimule cultivation (muli warg No.4 of Delampady village); thence skirting that cultivation, Korakkan darkhast muli warg No.7 of the same village) and muli wargs Nos. 4,5 and 6 of the village, north-north-west one hundred and seventy yards to cairn Nos.138, north-east the same distance to cairn No.139, north slightly west sixty five yards to cairn No.140, west one hundred yards to cairn No.141 and north two hundred yards to cairn No.142; thence passing along the south, east and north sides of Kuthimunda (muli wargs Nos. 3 and 7 of Delampady village), east-south east two hundred and forty yards to cairn No.143, east slightly south two hundred and ten yards to cairn No.144, east-south-east two hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.145, east one hundred and sixty yards to cairn No.146, north-east two hundred yards to cairn No.147, north slightly east the same distance to cairn No.148, west-north-west two hundred and forty-five yards to cairn No.149, west two hundred and fifty-five yards to cairn No.150, west-north-west two hundred and ten yards and one hundred and ninety-five yards to cairns Nos.151 and 152, west slightly north two hundred and eighty-five yards to cairn No.153, south-west two hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.154 and on slightly more west three hundred and ten yards to cairn No.155; hence west slightly south two hundred yards to cairn No.156, north two hundred and fifty yards to cairn No.157 and north-north-east one hundred and thirty yards to cairn No.158 overlooking Waltazy cultivation (muli warg No.10 of Delampady village); then passing along the east, north and west sides of the cultivation of muli warg No.1 of Kanakamajal village (viz, Kanthanamajal, Mogar Bail and Jalamule), east-north-east three hundred and thirty-five yards to cairn No.159, north-north east two hundred and sixty yards to cairn NO.160, north-east two hundred and thirty yards to cairn No.161, east slightly south two hundred and forty-five yards and two hundred and seventy five yards to cairns Nos. 162 and 163, north slightly east one hundred and thirty-five yards to cairn No.164, north slightly west one hundred and eighty yards to cairn No.165, west slightly north two hundred and forty-five yards to cairn No.166, north-west two hundred and seventy yards and two hundred and twenty five yards to cairns Nos. 167 and 168, west slightly north two hundred and fifty-five yards to cairn No.169, north-west three hundred and ten yards to cairn No.170, west-north-west three hundred and fifty yards to cairn No.171, west-south west one hundred and eighty yards and two hundred and five yards to cairns Nos. 172 and 173, south one hundred and seventy yards to cairn No.174, south-south-west two hundred and fifteen yards to cairn No.175, south-east one hundred and eighty yards to cairn No.176, east-south-east one hundred and fifty yards to cairn No.177 and south-south-east one hundred and seventy yards to cairn No.178, thence west slightly south one hundred and seventy yards to cairn No.179, west three hundred and

ten yards to cairn No.180 and on in the same direction two hundred and fifty yards to cairn No.181 and north-west the same distance to cairn No.182 overlooking Shantimale darkhast (mulu warg No.15 of Delampady village); thence passing along the eastern and northern sides of that cultivation, north two hundred and sixty yards to cairn No.183 west slightly north two hundred yards to cairn No.184 and west two hundred and forty-five yards to cairn No.185, thence north-north-west two hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.186 overlooking Palastadka cultivation (mulu warg No.12 of Delampady village) from the south-east; thence passing along the eastern and northern sides of that cultivation, north slightly east two hundred and fifteen yards to cairn No.187 and west two hundred and twenty yards to cairn No.188; thence passing along the eastern side of Kamatadka cultivation (mulu warg No.33 of Mudnur village); north-north-east two hundred and thirty yards to cairn No.189 north two hundred and fifty yards to cairn No.190 and north-north- east two hundred and eighty-five yards to the starting point, cairn No.1.

**REMARKS :** A. The following enclosure is admitted within the reserve, being itself free from reservation: -

I. Kasaragod – Jalsur Local fund road, to a width of forty-four yards, i.e. twenty-two yards on either side of a line drawn along the centre thereof. It enters the reserve between cairns Nos.72 and 73, fifteen yards east of the thirteen mile stone, runs first west and then south-west for a total distance of two furlongs and quits it on the east side of cairn No.88 again entering the reserve on the last side of cairns 87, it runs again south-west about two furlongs and quits it on the north side of cairn No.78.

B the following easements will be allowed to be exercised within the reserve:-

1. Permission is accorded to the cultivator or cultivators, for the time being of Pujaripalu, Ganigarmule, Acharimule and Bagithimaru, all of mulu warg No.1 of Kanakamajalu village, to construct a dam within the reserve across a stream therein some three hundred and sixty yards north east of cairn No.170 on the reserve boundary and to obtain for the construction there of from unclassified trees within the reserve in the vicinity of the dam two poles, fifteen feet long and six inches thick, twenty-five forked sticks, five feet long and three inches thick and ten head-loads of twigs, also from the bed of the stream, which, for the purpose of this order, will not exceed fifteen feet in breadth, such earth and stones as are required for a dam fifteen feet long, three feet high and three feet thick; also to lead off water from the southern and of the dam in a channel four feet broad, passing generally south-west ward through the reserve and quitting it on the east side of cairn No.170 on the boundary thereof. Right of entry into the reserve for the construction of the dam and maintenance of the channel will be

by the bed of the channel within the limits specified thereof and the maintenance of the channel will be executed with material taken from the bed thereof. This easement will be in force from June yearly for the succeeding five months.

II. Permission is accorded to the District Board Engineer, or such person as may be authorised by him, to issue permits, to his road coolies to enter the reserve for collecting metal for repair of the Mangaliore-Mercara road from a quarry situate two hundred yards within the reserve, some two hundred and fifty yards north-west of cairn No.28 of the reserve boundary. The area of the quarry will not exceed fifty-three yards north to south ninety-nine yards east to west, the nearest point thereof being two hundred yards west of the road above mentioned.

III. Permission is accorded to the cultivator, for the time being, of Jalamula, a portion of muli warg No.1 of Kanakamajalu village, to keep in repair, throughout the year, a tank within the reserve situate eight yards north-west of cairn No.174; there is no channel from the tank, the water thereof running down a natural ravine to the warg lands at the foot of the hill on which it is located. The size of the tank will not exceed twenty yards of twenty yards and the material for its repair will be obtained from the bed thereof within the limits specified thereof. Right of entry into the reserve for the maintenance of the tank will be by a path three feet wide for men only, entering the reserve seventy-five yards north of cairn No.174 and proceeding direct to the tank westward.

IV. Permission is accorded to the Cultivator, for the time being, of muli warg No.6 of Kanakamajalu village to keep in repair the bund of a tank situate within the reserve one hundred and ten yards east of cairn No.56 of the reserved boundary; the bund will be of earth and stones obtained from the bed of the tank formed such bed for the purpose of this order not exceeding eighty square yards, viz, ten yards long by eight broad; also to lead off water therefrom by a channel three feet broad, leaving the tank at its north-western corner, passing through the reserve north-west ward and quitting it thirty yards north of cairn No.56. Height of entry into the reserve for the construction of the bund and maintenance of the channel will be by the bed of the channel within the limits specified thereof; the easement will be in force throughout the year.

6. The following public rights of way will be admitted for the use of the public within the reserve:-

I. Yerahalabail – Mercara ghat road cart – track, to a width of ten feet, for men, cattle and carts; enters the reserve forty yards north of cairn No.17, passes east about three-fourth



furlong and quits it on the Local fund road from Puttur to Mercara one hundred and thirty yards east of cairn No.18.

II. Guddadka - Mogarubail forest road, to a width of ten feet for men, cattle and carts; enters the reserve twenty yards south-east of cairn No.22 runs west about two furlongs and then south-south-west a little over a furlong and quits it on the west side of cairn No.170.

III. Nidil Mogarubail foot-path, to a width of six feet, for men cattle and carts; enters the reserve forty-five yards north of cairn No.36, runs in a west-north-westerly direction about one and a half furlongs and quits it on the north side of cairn No.164.

IV. Markanji Mogarubail foot-path, to a width of six feet, for men and cattle.; enters the reserve ninety yards east of cairn No107 runs in a generally northerly direction a little over two furlongs and quite it on the east side of cairn No.53 again entering the reserve sixty-six yards north to cairn No.53 it runs west half-a-furlong and quits it on the south side of cairn No.110; re-entering the reserve on the south side of cairn No.118 it runs west about a furlong and quite it on the north side of cairn No.123; entering the reserves once more forty yards west & cairn no. 127 it runs north-north-westerly direction about one and a half furlongs and on the east side of cairn No.145; finally entering the seventy yards south-west of cairn No.153, it runs in a north direction about one and a half furlongs and quits it forty north-east of cairn No.159.
