

NOTIFICATION

Fort St. George, February, 1899

No. 82

His Excellency of the Governor in Council is pleased to declare, under the provisions of section 16 of the madras Forest Act (V of 1882), that, from the 1st June, 1899, the area, the boundaries of which are set fourth in the schedule appended to this notification, shall be constituted a reserved forest.

DISCRIPTION OF BOUNDARIES

North:- Starting from the junction of Puthalam and Kommeri Desams on the north, east-wards along the northern boundary of the latter desam to the north-west corner of the Vakkalam Desam thence the north boundary of that desam to the western side of the Tellichery – Coorg road.

East:- South along the western side of the the Tellichery – Coorg road to the northernmost point of survey No.7 of Vekkala desam and along the western side of that survey number and Survey numbers 6 and 5 of the same desam to the Tellichery – Manantoddy road.

South:- thence westwards along the northern side of the – Manantoddy-Tellichery road to the south east corner of Survey No. 1, north along the eastern and west along the northern boundary of that number and then along the northern and western sides of Survey No.2, both of Vekkala desam back to the Local Fund road thence westwards along the northern

side of the local fund road to the south – east corner of Survey No. 35, thence along the eastern and northern side of N0. 36, the eastern northern and western sides of No. 37 to the north – east corner of No.38, then the northern side of the latter number to its junction with survey No.7; then along the eastern sides of the surveys No.7, 11 and 12, then north-west along north –eastern sides of Survey No. 22,21 and 20 north along the eastern and northern sides of Survey No. 17 south west along the northern side of survey no. 16 south and south east along the west side of survey no.16 south along the western sides of Survey numbers 15 and 14 and the western and southern sides of Survey No. 20 to the junction of the south side of that number with survey no.21, South along the western side of Survey No. 21 to the northernmost point of Survey No. 13; then along the northern, western and southern sides of that number to its south-east corner; thence along the western side of Survey No. 12, northern and western sides of Survey No. 10, western sides of Survey Nos. 9 and 7 (all of Kommeri Desam) back to the Local Fund road; thence westwards along that road to the south-west corner of Survey No. 8 of Puthalam Desam, north along the eastern side of that number and west along the northern sides of Survey No. 8, 7 and 6 of Puthalam Desam to the north-western corner of the last mentioned number.

West.- Thence northwards along the western boundary of the escheat land in Puthalam Desam, to the starting point.

Remarks:- (a) The following enclosures are admitted within the reserve.

ENCLOSURE No. 1

Survey Nos. 2 and 3 of Puthalam Desam with right of entry and exit by paths Nos. 1 and 2 below:

ENCLOSURE No. 2

Survey No. 2 of the Kommeri Desam with right of entry from the Tellicherry-Manantoddy Local Fund road adjoining it on its southern side.

(b) The following public rights of way are admitted within the reserve:-

Foot-Path No.1, to a width of four feet for omen and cattle, enters the reserve at the north-western corner of Survey No. 6 of Puthalam Desam and running along the reserve boundary some five furlongs passes north-east one and-a-half furlongs and quits the reserve on the south side of Survey No. 2 of the same Desam.

Foot-Path No.2, to a width of four feet for men and cattle, enters the reserve at the middle of the north-west side of Survey No. 3 of Puthalam Desam, passes north-west for three furlongs and quits it at a point on the reserve boundary one and-a-half a miles north of the Local Fund Road.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 17-A of the Madras Forest Act, 1882 (Madras Act V of 1882), the Government of Madras are hereby pleased to redefine the limits of Kannoth extension reserved forest in Kottayam Taluk, Malabar District, so as to remove the defects in the description of the limits of the said forest in Revenue Department Notification No. 82, dated, the 18th February, 1899, published at page 200 of Part I of the Fort St. George Gazette dated the 21st February, 1899, by making the following correction to the limits of the said forest : -

Correction

For the Schedule to the said notification the following schedule shall be substituted namely:-

SCHEDULE

Malabar District, Kottayan Taluk, Vekkalam amsom, Vekkalam Kommeri and Puthalam Desams

(Name of Forest – Kannoth Extension. Area in acres – 1,110,56).

DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARIES

North. Starting from the south-west corner of Survey No. 1 of Vekkalam Desam (trijunction of Kommeri, Vayannur and Vekkalam Desams) the boundary line runs eastwards along the south side of the said Survey No. till it meets the Nidumpoyil-Iritti road at Survey No. 35.

East:- Thence the line runs southwards along the west margin of the said road (Survey Nos. 35 and 37 to 40) till it meets the northernmost corner of Survey No. 41; hence along the west side of that number jof the Tellicherry-Manantoddy Road at Survey No. 42.

South:- Thence the line runs along the north margin of the said road (Survey Nos. 42, 43, 44 and part of 45) to the south east corner of Survey No. 46; thence along the east, north and west sides of Survey No. 46 to the said road again at Survey 45 thence along the north margin of the said road (Survey Nos, 45,47 and 48 – all the above survey numbers are of Vakkalam Desam and 23 to 21) to the easternmost corner of Survey No. 8 of Kommeri Desam; thence along the east sides of Survey Nos. 8 and 6 east and north sides of Survey No. 5, east side of Survey No. 4, east and north sides of Survey No.3, north, west and south sides of Survey No.1, south sides of Survey No.4, west and south sides of Survey No.5 and west sides of Survey No. 6 to the north-east corner of Survey No. 7; thence along the north and west sides of Survey No. 7 till it meets the Tellicherry-Manantoddy road at Survey No. 9; thence along the north margin of the said road (Survey No. 9 to 13), till it meets the south-east corner of Survey No. 14; thence along the east, north and west sides of Survey No. 14, (the above survey numbers are all of Kommeri Desam) till it meets the said road at Survey No. 66; thence along the north-margin of the said road (Survey Nos. 66,65 and 64 to the south-east corner of Survey No. 57)

West. Thence the line runs along the east and north sides of Survey No. 57 to the south-east corner of Survey No. 45, thence along the east sides of Survey Nos 45,29,27 and 21 to the south-west corner of Survey No. 23, thence along the south and east sides of Survey No. 23 to the southernmost corner of Survey No. 25 and thence along the east sides of Survey No. 25 and 23 again to the starting point of the northern boundary (all the above survey numbers are of Puttalam Desam)

Remarks:- The following rights of way are admitted with the
reserve:-

- (1) A foot path (for which there is no local name) is open to men and cattle. It is four feet wide and two furlongs and three chains in length. It enters the reserve at the easternmost corner of Survey No. 45 of Puttalam Desam and runs in a north-easterly direction till it meets a point on the south side of Survey No. 70 of the said desam seven chains south-east of its westernmost corner.
- (2) A foot-path (for which there is no local name) is open to men and cattle. It is four feet wide and one furlong and eight chains in length. It enters the reserve on the western boundary at a point four chains south of the north-eastern corner of Survey No. 27 of Puttalam Desam and runs in a south-easterly direction till it meets the westernmost corner of Survey No. 70 of Puttalam Desam.
