

Whereas an emergency has arison which makes it expedient to prohibit the landing at, or embarking from, the ports within Travancore, of persons without passports: We are pleased to command as follows:—

No. 115/1 the major portion of S. No. 112/1, 114/1 and 116/1, a small portion of S. No. 75/1 of Manimala village, the major portion of S. No. 372/1 and a small portion of S. No. 357/1 of Kanjirapalli village, Peermade taluk. North:—Starting from cairn No. I situated south of the foot path from Karikkattur to Yerumali, near Theongapala and about 2½ chains west of Kandam stone, at the south-east corner of S. - II. Public rights within the Reserve.
- (1) Right of way. There is a right of way over a road from Chernvalli Estate to the Manimala Ranni road passing through the reserve and constructed at the experse of the Estate Proprietors, as per agreement entered into by them with the Government.

Description of the road is as follows:-

The road within the Reserve is 78 chains, 84 links long and 18 ft. wide. This road enters The road within the Reserve is 78 chains, 84 links long and 18 ft, wide. This road enters the reserve on the northern boundary between carm Nos 17 and 18 about 6 chains—south-east of the former carm and runs in a south westerly direction for about 7_4^2 chains thence in a southerly direction for about 8 chains and thence in a south south westerly direction for about 54_2^4 chains and thence westward for about $5\frac{1}{2}^4$ chains to neet the southern boundary of the reserve at about 2 chains north—west of cairn No. 202 and thence leaves the Reserve.
