As per the Government Order (Rt) 3/90/Forest dt. 18-1-1990, forest stations are formed by reorganising the forest sections in Konni and Ranni Divisions of Pathanamthitta district. The 12 forest sections in Konni, Naduvathumoozhy and Mannarappara Ranges of Konni Division are reorganised to 7 forest stations and the 13 forest sections in Ranni, Vadasserikkara and Goodrical Ranges of Ranni Forest Division are reorganised to 9 forest stations.

RANNI FOREST DIVISION

RANNI RANGE

1. Name of forest station : Karikulam
Headquarters : Kakkudumon

Boundaries

North: - Northern boundary of Ranni Division meets Pamba river.

East and South: - Thence along Pamba river down streams to the confluence of Arappumparathodu and Pamba river and thence Arrappumparathodu up stream where it crosses Rajampara reserve forest boundary thence along the Rajampara reserve forest boundary where it meets Bethanimala Mannupuzha road through Kolamala gate thence along the above said road up to Bethanimala, thence along the Bethanimala road up to Bethanimala where the said meets Madathummoozhy Athikkayam road thence along the road up to Madathummoozhy junction thence along Chalakkayam-Mannarakulanji road where it crosses Kakkaduar.

West: - Thence along Kakkaduar up to confluence of Kakkaduar and Pamba river thence along Pamba river and sown stream up to confluence of Kallar with Pamba river thence along the Kallar up stream where it crosses Mannarakulanji-Vadasserikkara road at Vadasserikkara bridge thence along division boundary up to starting point.
