

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by Section 25 of Act V of 1882 (The Madras Forest Act) the Right Honourable the Governor of for St. George in Council is pleased to declare the blocks of forest land described in the schedule here to annexed to be "Reserved Forests and subject to all conditions and penalties prescribed for reserved Forests by Chapter II of the said Act, from and after the 1st March 1884.

SCHEDULE

No. 2 District - Malabar, Taluk - Ernad Block - Karimpoya

BOUNDARIES

North: Yellampadam, Pathakalampadam, Pulapoil, Shangarakod Padam,
Kaliampadam Shemban padam and Kalianthode.

South: Kurram pulam Cheru Pula, Seringaen Tode and Kallamalai Tode.

East Forest and Kariri padam belonging to the Amerambalam Rajah Forest belonging to the Zemorin Rajah and Cherupula

West: Krurram Pula.

Area - Acres : 4014.00

Remarks - B.P. Forest No. 715 dated 3-3-1884.

Right of way 10 yards in width for men, cattle and implements from Chengarangod padam to Karimpuzha river along the line between compartments 292, 288, 289, 285 and 290 crossing the road from Chanakundu mukku to Nedumgayam.
