Situation: - The Block is situated to the south of Kottur Reserve and to the west of Klamala Reserve and comprises the whole of Survey Nos. 436/1, 437/1 and 2 and also the River Poramboke in Survey No. 436/2 and portion of Survey No. 440/1 of Ottasekharamangalam Kani lands, Neyyattikara Taluk.

**BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION**

**North:** Starting from cairn No.1 on the right bank of the Neyyar river at the south west corner of Survey No. 436/2 (Neyyar river) of Ottasekharamangalam Kani lands on the Kottur Reserve boundary, the line runs more or less in a northeast direction along the right bank of the river to cairn NO.2 about 3 chains north by slightly west of a cairn in the Klamala reserve boundary on a Khandom stone on the left bank of the river at the north east corner of Survey No. 437/1 where the Khandom line meets the river.

**East:** Thence the line crosses the river in a southerly direction and meets the above said Khandom line and stone on the left bank of the river, thence southward for about 77chains along the western boundary of Klamala Reserve to a cairn on it situated at the south east corner of Survey No. 437/1 on the boundary stone between Ottaskharamanglam and Kunnathukal village.

**South and West:** Thence west by slightly north for about 3 chains along the above village boundary passing cairn No. 3 to cairn No.4; thence west south west for about  $1 \frac{1}{4}$  chains to cairn No. 5; thence more or less south for about 5 chains passing cairn Nos. 6 and 7 to cairn No.8; thence south east for about  $1 \frac{1}{2}$  chains to cairn No.9 at the village boundary stone; thence southwest for about  $1 \frac{3}{4}$  chains to cairn No.10; thence south southwest for about  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  chains passing cairn No.11 cairn No.12; thence south for about  $2 \frac{1}{4}$  chains to cairn No.13 at the village boundary stone; thence west south west for about  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  chains to cairn No. 14; thence south, south west for about 3 chains passing cairn No. 15 to cairn No. 16 at the village boundary stone, thence west by . Slightly north for about 5 chains passing cairn No. 17 to cairn No. 18 at the village boundary stone; thence north northwest for about  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  chains to cairn No. 19; thence west for about  $3 \frac{1}{2}$  chains to cairn No. 20 at the village boundary stone; thence south east for about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a chain to cairn No. 22; thence south west for about 1 chain to cairn No. 23 at the village boundary stone on the western most corner of survey No. 780/1 of Kunnathukal Village; thence in the same direction for about  $3 \frac{1}{2}$  chains and crossing the Karippar thode to cairn No. 24 at the village boundary stone, thence more or less north west for about 14 chains along the above said village boundary passing cairn No. 25 and 26 to cairn No. 27 at the village boundary stone; thence north northwest for about  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  chains to cairn No. 28; thence north west for about 2 chains to cairn No.29 thence north east for about 2 chains to cairn No.30; thence west north west for about  $4 \frac{1}{2}$  chains to cairn No.31; at the village boundary stone; thence north for about 2 chains to cairn No. 32; thence more or less northwest for

about 17 chains passing cairn Nos.33 to 36 to cairn No. 37; at the village boundary stone, thence north by slightly west for about 6 ½ chains to cairn No. 38; thence west by slightly south for about 1 ¾ chains to cairn No.39 at the village boundary stone; thence north west for about 4 ½ chains passing cairn No.40 to cairn No. 41; thence west northwest for about 4 ½ chains to cairn No. 42 at the village boundary stone, thence north west for about 4 ½ chains to cairn No. 42 at the village boundary stone; thence north northwest for about 3 ¾ chains to cairn No. 43; thence west by slightly north for about 4 chains to cairn No.44 at the village boundary stone; thence north west for about 4 chains to cairn No. 45 at the village boundary stone; thence northwest for about 5 ½ chains passing cairn No. 46 (on a theodolite stone) to cairn No. 47; thence west by slightly south for about 2 ½ chains to cairn-to-cairn No. 48 at the village boundary stone; thence northwest for about 2 chains to cairn No. 49 on the left bank of the Neyyar river. (The boundary line from 3 to cairn No. 49 runs along the said village boundary) thence north west for about 3 ½ chains along the south side of Survey No. 436/2 (river) and crossing the river to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.

Remarks. There are no private or public rights within the Reserve.

S.R.O.No.1346/84: - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of Kerala Forest Act, 1961 (4 of 1962), the Government of Kerala hereby declare that it is proposed to constitute the lands, the situation and limits of which are specified in the Schedule below as a Reserved Forest and appoint the Revenue Divisional Officer, Trivandrum as the Forest Settlement Officer to enquire into and determine the existence, nature and extent of any right claimed by alleged to exist in favour of any person in or over any land comprised within the limits of the proposed reserved forest or to any forest produce of such land and to deal with the same as provided in the Act .

## BOUNDARIES

**North:** Starting from the station No. 1, which is situated at the north west corner of the area the boundary goes north east about 302.6 M. Passing stations 2 to 9 thence the boundary goes due east for about 1002.4 M passing stations 10 to 31, further north for about 102.2 M passing 32 to 33, again north for about 91.4 M passing stations 34 and 35 to 36 further south by slightly east for about 386.6 M passing stations 37 to 46 thence south for about 232.2 M passing stations 50 to 52 thence north east for about 139.2 M passing station 53 to 54 thence north east for about 290.6 M passing stations 55 and 56 to 57 again north west for about 53.4M passing station 58 to 60 , further east for about 356.8 M passing station 61 to 66 and to station 67.

**East:** thence the boundary goes due to south for about 25.12 M passing stations 68 to 131 and station 132.

**South:** Thence the boundary goes west for about 138.6M passing stations 133 to 137 further west for about 846.4 M passing station 38 to 55 and again due west for about 529.2M, passing station 156 to 167.

**West:** thence the boundary goes north east for about 469.4M passing station 168 to 177 further north for about 239.6 M passing station 179 to 181 again west for about 137.6 M passing station 182 to 184 again north for about 245.4 M passing station No. 185 to 193 further 32.2 M west to station 194 thence south for about 102.6 M passing station 195 to 196 further west for about 241.2M passing station 107, 108 to 201 further north west for about 292.4 M passing station 201 to 206 thence south for about 155.8 M passing station 207 to 208 thence south for about 155.8 M passing station 209 to 228 further west for about 221.4 M assign station 229 to 233 ; thence south for about 629.8 M passing station 234 to 250 further south west for about 211.4 M passing station 251 to 254 thence north west for about 714.2 M passing station 255 to 269 and to the station No. 1 the starting point of the area.
