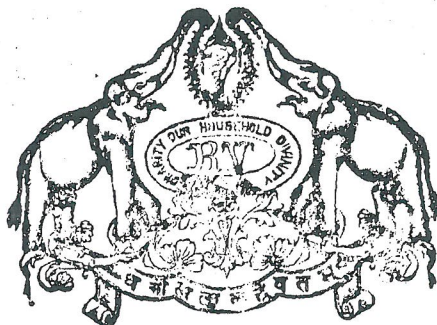

NOTICE

Is hereby given for general information that auction sales of timbers, etc., lying at the undernoted depots of the various Forest Divisions of the Department will be conducted on the dates noted against each by the respective Divisional Forest Officers.

2. The auction sale will commence at 1 P. M. precisely.

3. Intending bidders must deposit a sum of B. Rs. (25) twenty-five as earnest money or they will not be allowed to bid. This money will be returned to them, directly the auction is over, if no purchase is made, or will be deducted from the 1/3 purchase money referred to in para 5 below; but if the purchaser does not pay the 1/3 amount on the spot the earnest money deposited by him will be credited to Government.

4. The sale shall, in each case, be knocked down to the highest bidder subject to the condition that in all cases where the price bid for timber is below the tariff value or the sale amount exceeds Rs. 1,000 in each sale and in all cases where the produce has no tariff rates in force and where the sale amount does not exceed Rs. 200, the sale shall be confirmed by the Conservator of Forests, all other sales of the latter class requiring confirmation by the Government.

5. The purchaser must pay 1/3 of the bid amount on the spot and the balance within 30 days from the date of issue of notice of confirmation of the sale and remove the timber within that time. If all the money is not paid within the time specified, the 1/3 amount previously deposited will be credited to Government and the timber resold. The defaulting purchaser shall, in such cases of re-sale, be liable to make good to Government the loss and expenses if any resulting from such re-sale; but shall not be entitled to the advantage or gain, if any. If, however, the timber is not re-sold but allowed to be removed by the original purchaser himself he shall be called on to pay ground rent as laid down in the rules regulating the measurement and storage of timbers in depots published in the Gazette dated 29th Medom 1984 and the subsequent amendments thereon.

6. The species and quantity of timber available for sale each time as well as other particulars can be ascertained from the respective Depot Officers or the Divisional Forest Officers concerned.

NOTIFICATION.

R. Dis. No. 210/23.
The Anakulam Reserve was constituted under Section 4 of the Forest Regulation II of 1068 and the Notification published in the Government Gazette dated 21-7-03/6-12-78. But owing to the adjudication of certain claims within the Reserve the originally notified area was split up into two separate blocks—namely Anakulam North and Anakulam South blocks. The Anakulam south block was finally notified under Section 18 of Forest Regulation II of 1068 as per G. O. No. 2342/F. & M. R., dated 19th June 1915 and the Notification published in the Government Gazette dated 6th July 1915.
Now it is hereby notified under Section 18 of Regulation II of 1068 as amended by Regulation IV of 1071 and IX of 1085, that from and after this date, Anakulam North Block, specified in the subjoined schedule, shall be deemed to be a Reserved Forest.

Nos. 547/1, 335/1 and 419/1, the line runs more or less south east along the left bank of, and up the Achencoil river, to cairn No. 2 near a revenue

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survey stone at a sharp bend on the eastern limit of S. No. 547/1 situated just north of the point where the Kadiyar stream meets the Achencoll river and 7.29 chains north north east of the tri-junction stone of S. Nos. 872/1 of Pathanapuram and 547/1 and 545/1 of Kumbazha pakuthies.

East. Thence south south west along the eastern side of S. No. 547/1 running through the Kadiyar stream to cairn No. 3 situated at the last mentioned tri junction.

South. Thence more or less northwest along the northern limits of S. Nos. 545/1 and 544/1 of Kumbazha pakuthi, passing cairn Nos. 4 to 52 to cairn No. 53 situated on the northern limit of S. No. 544/1, thence skirting the area encroached upon by the Rubber Plantation Investment Trust Co., and marked No. 2 in the map in a northerly direction for a distance of 1.76 chains to cairn No. 54, thence north north easterly for a distance of 2.29 chains passing cairn No. 55 to cairn No. 56, thence more or less north westerly for 4.55 chains passing cairn Nos. 57 and 58, to cairn No. 59, thence north north east for 2.89 chains passing cairn No. 60 to cairn No. 61 situated on the northern limit of S. No. 544/1; thence more or less in a northerly direction along the northern limit of the above S. No. passing cairn Nos. 62 and 63 to cairn No. 64 situated on a revenue survey theodolite station; thence skirting another area encroached upon by the above company and marked (No. 3) in a north westerly direction for a distance of 5 chains, passing cairn No. 65 to cairn No. 66 situated at a point on the northern limit of S. No. 544/1 about 1½ chains, south east of a sharp bend on the above limit, thence again north westerly along the same limit of the same S. No. for about 1½ chains to cairn No. 67 situated at the above said bend; thence south west for 34 links to cairn No. 68, thence skirting another area encroached upon by the above Company and marked (No. 4) in a north westerly direction for about 8.42 chains passing cairn Nos. 69 to 72 to cairn No. 73 thence south west for 2.11 chains passing cairn No. 74 to cairn No. 75, thence north west for about 15½ chains, passing cairn Nos. 76 to 80 to cairn No. 81 situated on the northern limit of the above S. No., thence again north west along the same limit of the above S. No. passing cairn Nos. 82 and 83 to cairn No. 84; thence skirting another area encroached upon by the above company and marked (No. 5) in a westerly direction for 2.34 chains to cairn No. 85; thence north westerly for 5.66 chains passing cairn No. 86 to cairn No. 87; thence westerly for 2.55 chains passing cairn No. 88 to cairn No. 89; thence more or less north north westerly for 7.04 chains passing cairn Nos. 90 to 93 to cairn No. 94 on the same limit of the above S. No., thence north westerly along the same limit of the above S. No. passing cairn No. 95 to cairn No. 96; thence leaving the limit of the above S. No. and skirting another area encroached upon by the above company and marked (No. 6) in a north westerly direction for 1.89 chains passing cairn No. 97 to cairn No. 98, thence west north westerly for 1.74 chains to cairn No. 99, situated on the Revenue survey line, thence north westerly along the same Revenue survey line to cairn No. 100 situated near a theodolite station at a sharp bend; thence west south westerly for 2.58 chains to cairn No. 101 on the Revenue survey line, thence skirting another area encroached upon by the above company and marked (No. 7) in a more or less north westerly direction for 19.86 chains passing cairn Nos. 102, to 108, to cairn No. 109 situated on the same revenue survey line; thence north westerly along the same Revenue survey line passing cairn No. 110 to cairn No. 112, to cairn No. 113, situated on the revenue survey line; thence skirting another area encroached upon by the above company and marked (No. 8 A), in a north westerly direction for 3.12 chains passing cairn No. 114 to cairn No. 115, thence westerly for 2.40 chains to cairn No. 116; thence south westerly for 0.84 chains to cairn No. 117, thence west for 2.44 chains to cairn No. 118; thence west north westerly for 2.48 chains to cairn No. 119 situated on the revenue survey line; thence again skirting another area encroached upon by the above company and marked (No. 8 B) in a north westerly direction for 2.93 chains to cairn No. 120; thence more or less north north westerly for 4 chains passing cairn No. 121 and 122 to cairn No. 123 situated on the revenue survey line; thence again the same direction along the same survey line for about 1.18 chains passing cairn No. 124 to cairn No. 125, thence skirting another area encroached upon by the above company and marked (No. 8 C) in a north westerly direction for 3.15 chains to cairn No. 126 situated on the Revenue Survey line; thence along the same survey line for 1.79 chains to cairn No. 127, thence again skirting another area encroached upon by the above company and marked (No. 9) in a north westerly direction for 2.15 chains to cairn No. 128, thence more or less westerly for 5.48 chains passing cairn No. 129 to cairn No. 130 situated on the above said revenue survey line; thence north westerly along the same revenue survey line passing cairn Nos. 131 and 132 to cairn No. 133; thence leaving the survey line and skirting another area encroached upon by the above company and marked (No. 10) in a north westerly direction for 3.92 chains to cairn No. 134, thence west by slightly south for 1.14 chains to cairn No. 135, situated on the eastern side of S. No. 419/1, thence northerly along the same limit of the same S. No. to cairn No. 136, thence leaving the survey line north north westerly through S. No. 419/1 for 2.40 chains to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.

REMARKS. The boundary between cairn Nos. 53 to 61, 64 to 66, 68 to 81, 84 to 94, 96 to 99, 101 to 109, 113 to 123, 124 to 126, 127 to 130 and 133 to 135 runs through S. No. 547/1 leaving the northern limit of S. No. 544/1 and throws out from the Reserve the eleven bits of encroachments made within the former S. No. by the Rubber Plantation Investment Trust Co., Ltd. The 23 cents of teak are in S. No. 419/1 B registered in the name of the above company have been acquired and included in the Reserve by exchange of an equal area from the portions of the Reserve encroached upon by the company.
