Situation :—The Reserve is situated about half a mile to the west of Pathanamthitta—Konnir road between the 5th and 8th miles and comprises the whole of Survey Nos. 220/1041, 220/139A, 220/138A, 220/140A and 220/98A of Vallicode Pakuthy, the whole of Survey Nos. 432/1569, 432/1577, 432/1575, 432/1573, 432/1574 and 416/9 of Kodumon Pakuthy and the whole of Survey Nos. 788/1 and 783/798 of Enadimangalam Pakuthy.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION.

II. PUBLIC RIGHTS.

The following roads and foot paths are allowed to be used by the public and cattle at all times.

1. Koodal-Angadical road.

This road is about 34 chains in length and about 25 feet in width and passes through Survey Nos. 432/1573 and 432/1569 of Kodumon Pakuthy. It enters the reserve between cairn Nos. 315 and 316 and goes nearly north-west for about 2 chains and leaves the Reserve between cairn Nos. 320 and 321. It re-enters the Reserve between cairn Nos. 324 and 325 and goes nearly north-west for about 32 chains through Survey No. 432/1573 of Kodumon Pakuthy and leaves the Reserve between cairn Nos. 359 and 360 to Angadical.

2. Chandanathadikal-Kaithakara foot path.

This foot path which is about $72 \frac{1}{4}$ chains in length enters the Reserve at cairn No. 15 on the eastern boundary of the Chandanathadikal enclosure and goes nearly south-east for about $1 \frac{1}{4}$ chains; thence nearly east north east for about $2 \frac{1}{4}$ chains; thence nearly north-east for about $3 \frac{1}{4}$ chains; thence nearly north for about $6 \frac{1}{4}$ chains; thence nearly north-east for about $4 \frac{3}{4}$ chains; thence nearly north for about $2 \frac{1}{2}$ chains; thence nearly north-east for about $2 \frac{1}{3}$ chains; thence in the same direction but more to the east for about 11 chains; thence nearly east south east for about $8 \frac{1}{4}$ chains; thence nearly north east for about 13 chains; thence nearly north north-east for about $13 \frac{1}{2}$ chains; thence nearly east south-east for about $3 \frac{3}{4}$ chains and leaves the Reserve at cairn No. 155 on the outer boundary of the Reserve to Kaithakara.

3. Foot path from Chandanathadikal to Azhakootam.

This foot path, which is about $25 \frac{3}{4}$ chains in length starts from the Chandanathadikal—Kaithakara foot path mentioned above about $24 \frac{1}{2}$ chains north east of cairn No. 13 of Chandanathadikal enclosure and goes nearly west but slightly north for about $3 \frac{1}{2}$ chains; thence nearly north-west for about 3 chains; thence nearly west but slightly north for about $2 \frac{1}{4}$ chains; thence nearly north-west for about 10 chains; thence in the same direction but more to the north for about 7 chains and leaves the Reserve at cairn No. 90 on the outer boundary of the Reserve to Azhakootam.

4. Foot path from Muppramannu to Chandanathadikal via Ezlamon.

This foot path which is about $173 \frac{1}{4}$ chains in length enters the Reserve between cairn Nos. 19 and 20 at the 87th link from cairn No. 20 and runs more or less parallel to the Reserve boundary for about $8 \frac{1}{4}$ chains and leaves the Reserve between cairn Nos. 23 and 24 at the 164th link from the latter cairn. It re-enters the Reserve between cairn Nos. 24 and 25 at 180th link from the latter cairn and runs nearly parallel and close to the Reserve boundary for about $15 \frac{3}{4}$ chains and leaves the Reserve between cairn Nos. 30 and 31 at the 87th link from the latter cairn. It re-enters the Reserve between cairn Nos. 31 and 32 at the 141st link from the latter cairn and goes more or less parallel and close to the Reserve boundary for about 12 chains and leaves the Reserve between cairn Nos. 35 and 36 at the 200th link from the latter cairn. It re-enters the Reserve



between cairn Nos. 36 and 37 at the 183rd link from the latter cairn and goes nearly parallel and close to the Reserve boundary for about $5 \frac{3}{4}$ chains and leaves the Reserve between cairn Nos. 37 and 38 at the 392nd link from the latter cairn. It re-enters the Reserve between cairn Nos. 38 and 39 at the 4th link from the former cairn and goes nearly south-east for about $131 \frac{1}{2}$ chains and passing along the enclosure boundary of Kalappara enclosure from cairn No. 5 to 6 leaves the Reserve at cairn No. 1 on the enclosure boundary of Chandanathadikal enclosure.

3. Foot path from Ezhumon to Kottayam.

This foot path is about 38 chains in length and enters the Reserve between cairn Nos. 38 and 39 at 256th link from the latter cairn and goes more or less parallel and close to the Reserve boundary for about 34 1/2 chains and leaves the Reserve between cairn Nos. 50 and 51 at the 155th link from the latter cairn. It re-enters the reserve between cairn Nos. 51 and 52 at the 350th link from the latter cairn and goes nearly parallel and close to the Reserve boundary for about 3 1/2 chains and leaves the reserve between cairn Nos. 52 and 53 at the 10th link from the former cairn to Kottayam.

6. Foot path allowing access to enclosure Nos. 1, 2 and 3.

This foot path which is about 42 chains in length starts from the Koodal-Angadical road and enters the reserve at cairn No. 322 on the southern outer boundary of the reserve and goes more or less north east for about 1 chain; thence north north west for about $1\frac{3}{4}$ chains thence north east for about $4\frac{1}{4}$ chains, thence nearly north for about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains, thence nearly north north east for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains thence nearly north east for about $6\frac{1}{2}$ chains, thence in the same direction but more to the east for about $6\frac{1}{2}$ chains, thence nearly north east for about 3 chains, thence in the same direction but more to the east for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains and leaves the reserve at cairn No. 12 on the southern boundary of South Puthuseri enclosure. Again it enters the reserve at cairn No. 1 on the northern boundary of the above enclosure and goes more or less north for about $5\frac{3}{4}$ chains and leaves the Reserve at cairn No. 4 of the Puthussèri enclosure. Again it enters the reserve at cairn No. 1 of the above enclosure and goes more or less north west for about $4\frac{3}{4}$ chains and leaves the Reserve at cairn No. 10 of the Vallikottukal enclosure.

7. Foot path allowing access to enclosure No. 5 (Chirathittu enclosure.)

This foot path which is about $15\frac{1}{2}$ chains in length starts from the Chandanathadikal-Kaithakara foot path admitted within the reserve and enters the reserve at cairn No. 3 of Chandanathadikal enclosure and goes nearly north west through the reserve for about $15\frac{1}{2}$ chains and leaves it at cairn No. 5 on the southern boundary of Chirathitta enclosure.

There are no rights either public or private within the reserve other than those described above.

NOTE:—The width allowed for the foot-paths allowed within the Reserve is 10 links.

- As the admitted foot path from Muppparamannu to Chandanathadikal passes along the boundary of enclosure No. 4 (Kalappara) between cairn Nos. 5 and 6 no separate right of way to that enclosure is necessary.
