With the sauction of His Highness the Maharaja of Travancore it is hereby notified under Section 18 of the Forest Act II of 1068 as amended by Acts IV of 1071 IX of 1085, IV of 1089, VIII of 1097 and XII of 1112 that the tract specified in the subjected schedule shall be deemed to be a Reserved Forest with effect from the date of publication of this notification in the Government Gazette.

Cairns have been erected along the boundaries of the Reserve and a correct description of the boundaries with reference to the cairns is hereto appended for the information of the public.

Situation:—The Reserve is situated about half a mile to the west of Pathana-puram—Konni road between the 5th and 8th miles and comprises the whole of Survey Nos. 220/1041, 220/139A, 220/138A, 220/140 A and 220/98A of Vallicode Pakuthy, the whole of Survey Nos. 432/1569, 432/1577, 432/1575, 432/1573, 432/1574 and 416/9 of Kodumon Pakuthy and the whole of Survey Nos. 788/1 and 783/798 of Enadimangalam Pakuthy.
